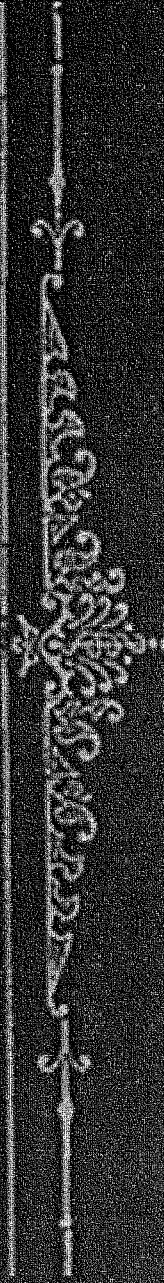

# FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY

- On-time budget four years in a row
- \$10.4 billion in debt repayments
- \$2.1 billion towards a Rainy Day Reserve Fund
- Reinvested in State social safety net with commitment to increases in childcare payments

# INVESTMENTS IN CHILDREN AND EDUCATION

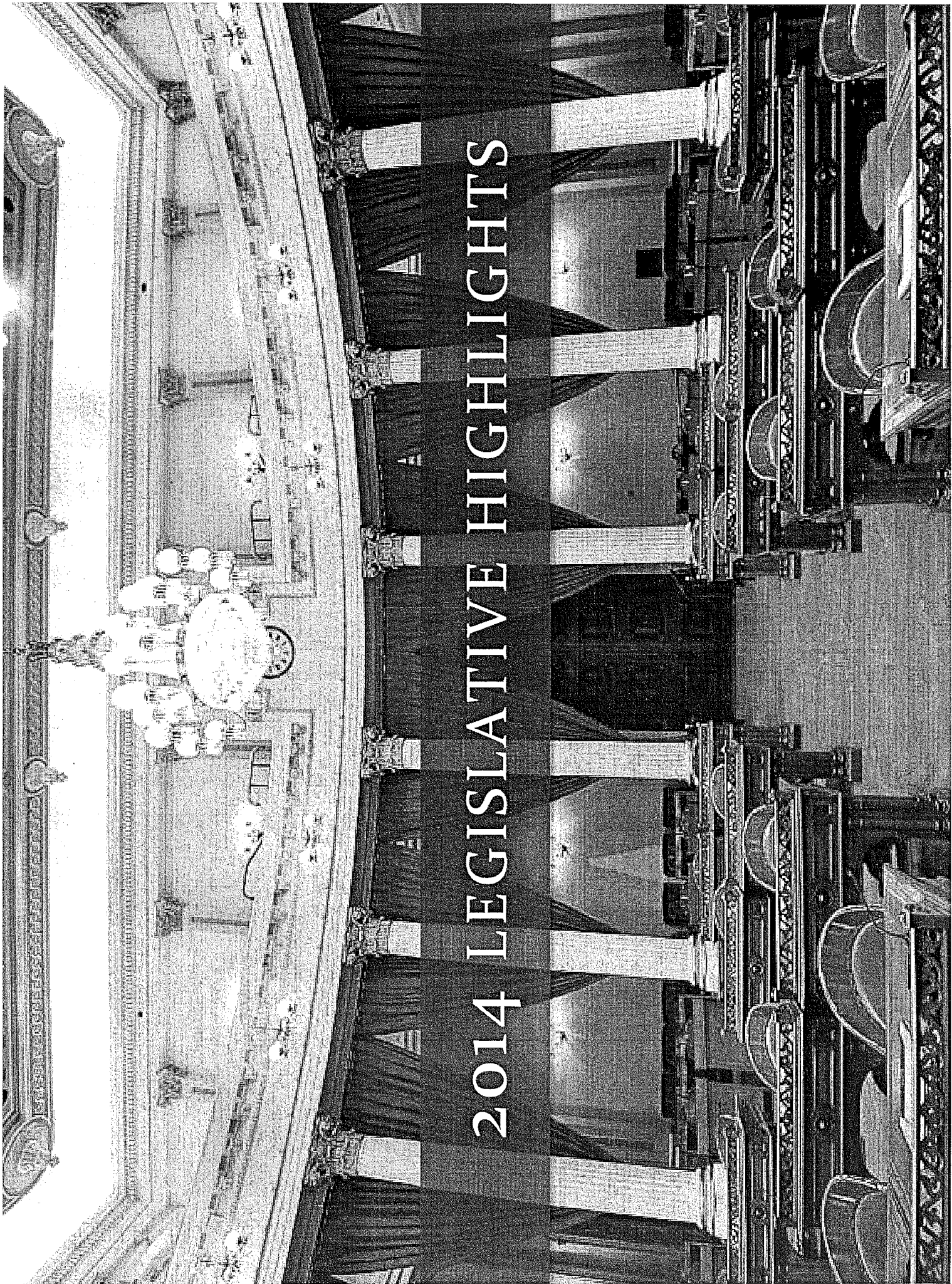
- Fair Start Pre-School Plan providing \$264 million this budget year
- Will serve 234,000 low-income 4-year olds – nearly half of all 4-year olds in California!
- \$250 million in funding for Career Pathways Trust Program
- UC and CSU will receive an extra \$50 million and \$100 million each for maintenance projects



# REDUCING GREENHOUSE GASES AND BUILDING SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES

- Reached deal with Governor on appropriation of future Cap and Trade revenues
- Secured \$200 million to low-carbon transportation
- Means better job-creation as California's economy continues to recover

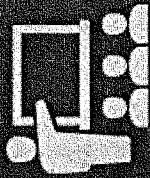
## PROTECTING LOCAL FUNDS

- AB1450 Garcia/Lara Bill to ensure that local tax dollars stay local
- Bill would ensure those tax revenues go back to the cities to offset cost of public pensions for city employees
- If cities don't get this money, they'd be forced to make difficult budget cuts such as public safety

# WATER BOND HIGHLIGHTS

- \$200 million for storm-water management
- \$30 million for watershed management through the Rivers and Mountains Conservancy
- \$200 million for improvements to the LA River, including the lower river
- Investments in stormwater capture, to keep pollutants out of storm drains and turn stormwater into a beneficial resource
- Funding for the San Gabriel and Lower Los Angeles Rivers and Mountains Conservancy for recreation and habitat restoration projects along the Lower Los Angeles River
