FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 35293

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 35293 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of May 14, 2020 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on June 12, 2018, by and between THE CHILDREN'S CLINIC 'SERVING CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES', a California nonprofit corporation ("Organization"), whose address is 701 East 28th Street, Suite 200, Long Beach, CA 90806, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City requires specialized services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with providing one or more of the following: transitional housing, permanent housing, human or social services to low-income and homeless residents in connection with a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") called the "Continuum of Care Program" ("CoC") which deals with the needs of the homeless; and

WHEREAS, City and Organization (the "Parties") entered into Subcontract
No. 35293 (the "Subcontract") whereby Organization agreed to provide these services; and
WHEREAS, this Amendment is a reallocation of CoC funds to support the
City's public health outbreak preparedness and response effort to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the total disbursement amount and update the Project Budget attached as Attachment "B" to the Subcontract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 4.B of the Subcontract is hereby amended to read as follows.
- "B. Total disbursements made to Organization under this Subcontract by the City shall not exceed One Hundred Thirty Thousand Four Hundred Twenty Nine Dollars (\$130,429) over the term of this Subcontract. Upon execution of this Subcontract, the City shall disburse funds payable hereunder in

due course of payments following receipt from Organization of billing statements in a form approved by the City showing expenditures and costs identified in Attachment "B"."

- 2. The Project Budget attached as Attachment "B" to the Subcontract is hereby amended and replaced with Attachment "B-1" attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- 3. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Subcontract No. 35293 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
