Disability Awareness Wonth

Phereas, the Congress of the United States, by joint resolution, approved August 11, 1945, as amended (36 U.S.C. 155), has designated October of each year as "National Disability Employment Awareness Month"; and

Whereas, the President of the United State has designated October as "National Disabilities Employment Awareness Month" as a special time for all Americans to recognize the tremendous potential of citizens with disabilities and to renew our commitment to full inclusion and equal opportunity for them, as for every citizen; and

Whereas, together we continue to shift disability policy, as well as attitudes, in America from exclusion to inclusion; from dependence to independence; from paternalism to empowerment; and

Whereas, 2006, marks the 16th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA); and


Whereas, the City of Long Beach reaffirms its commitment to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and to ensure equal opportunity and full access for persons with a disability; and

Whereas, the Citizens Advisory Commission on Disabilities will continue to advise the Mayor, City Council, and City Manager on matters affecting persons with a disability in the area of empowerment, health services, housing, transportation, recreation, and other life activities;

Now, Cherefore, I, Bob Foster, Mayor of the City of Long Beach, on behalf of the Long Beach City Council, do hereby proclaim October 2006, as Disability Awareness Month.

Whereas, the pain and suffering caused by mental illness are staggering for affected individuals and their families. In addition to treatment costs and lost productivity, persons with mental illness are often at risk for suicide, poverty, homelessness, and imprisonment due to lack of appropriate psychiatric response; and

Whereas, almost one in five of the population suffer from a diagnosable mental disorder in any given year, but nearly two-thirds of all people with diagnosable mental disorders do not seek treatment. Applying this data to the City of Long Beach, approximately 100,000 residents suffer from a mental illness, 66,000 of whom do not seek treatment; and

Whereas, with appropriate care and treatment, many people with mental illness can live productive and fulfilling lives. Through advocacy and education, the barriers to effective treatment can be diminished, from erasing the negative stigma to bringing understanding of the availability and effectiveness of mental health treatments; and

Whereas, observation of Mental Illness Awareness Week educates the Long Beach community on the importance of mental health services and encourages the acceptance of people with mental illness;

Now, Cherefore, I, Bob Foster, Mayor of the City of Long Beach, on behalf of the Long Beach City Council, do hereby proclaim October 1-7, 2006 as Mental Illness Awareness Week.
