## **RESOLUTION NO. C-28381**

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. C-28152 WHICH CERTIFIED PROJECT BUDGET, LOCAL FUNDING COMMITMENT, AND SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS FOR THE GRANT APPLICATION UNDER THE LIBRARY BOND ACT OF 2000

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the "California Reading and Literacy Improvement and Public Library Construction and Renovation Bond Act of 2000," also known as the Library Bond Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Library Bond Act authorized the sale of \$350 million of state general obligation bonds for the purpose of public library construction and renovation; and

WHEREAS, \$350 million of state grants are currently available on a 65% state to 35% local matching fund basis to cities, counties and library districts authorized to own and maintain a public library facility, for the construction and renovation of public library facilities in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, Library Bond Act grant application guidelines indicate that first priority for new libraries shall be given to joint-venture projects in which the agency that operates the library and one or more school districts have a cooperative agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach (Public Library) and the Long Beach Unified School District have a cooperative agreement to provide certain space, programs and services at the MacArthur Park Branch Library (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has completed all requirements to apply for this grant and originally requested \$6,342,118 in grant funds but the California State Library, Office of Library Construction, informed the City that the grant amount will actually be \$6,366,733 and has requested this amended resolution to confirm that amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

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Section 1.	The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
hereby by this reference.	

- The City commits to provide the local matching fund amount of Sec. 2. \$3,428,241 identified in the Library Project Budget, as required by Education Code Section 19995(a).
- The City commits to provide supplemental funds of \$305,000 Sec. 3. necessary to complete the Project as stated in the Project budget.
- The City certifies the availability of local matching and Sec. 4. supplemental funds at the level specified in the Project budget when they are needed to meet cash flow requirements for the Project.
- The City commits to the Project budget in the amount of Sec. 5. \$10,099,974 contained in the Library Project Budget section of the Application, contingent upon award of grant funding.
- The City attests to the accuracy and truthfulness of all Sec. 6. information submitted in the Application and the required supporting documents.
- The City commits to operate the completed facility and provide Sec. 7. public library direct service.
- The City commits that the facility shall be dedicated to the Sec. 8. public library direct service use for a period of 40 years following completion of the Project, regardless of any operating agreements the City may have with any other jurisdictions or parties.
- The City Council accepts local funding commitment and Sec. 9. supplemental funds for the grant application under the Library Bond Act of 2000 and appoints the City Manager as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and the like, which may be necessary for the completion of the Project.
- This resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by Sec. 10. the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
