Enclosed is a copy of the City Council documentation for your file.

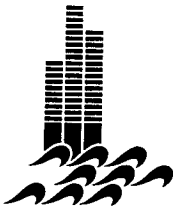

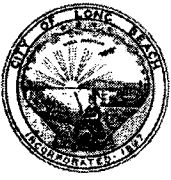
