3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT
6 WITH HOME DEPOT U.S.A. INC., FOR FURNISHING AND
7 DELIVERING MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, AND
8 OPERATIONS SUPPLIES AND MISCELLANEOUS
9 MATERIALS ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS, ON THE SAME
10 TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO MARICOPA
11 COUNTY, ARIZONA, THROUGH OMNIA PARTNERS, IN AN
12 ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000, WITH A 20%
13 CONTINGENCY OF \$200,000, FOR A TOTAL ANNUAL
14 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,200,000, UNTIL THE OMNIA
15 CONTRACT EXPIRES ON DECEMBER 31, 2026, WITH THE
16 OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS THE OMNIA
17 CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE
18 CITY MANAGER

20 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the
21 City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without
22 advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with other
23 government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

24 WHEREAS, the City requires maintenance, repair, and operations supplies
25 and miscellaneous materials on an as-needed basis; and

26 WHEREAS, Maricopa County, Arizona, through Omnia Partners, has a
27 contract with Home Depot U.S.A., Inc. for maintenance, repair, operating supplies,
28 industrial supplies, and related products and services, Contract No. Serial 16154-RFP

1 (“Maricopa County Contract”); and

2 WHEREAS, the City’s participation in the Maricopa County Contract will
3 facilitate timely acquisition of the maintenance, repair, and operations supplies and
4 miscellaneous materials on an as-needed basis as well as provide considerable cost
5 benefits to the City; and

6 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
7 Maricopa County Contract considerably more funds would be required;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
9 follows:

10 Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter an
11 agreement with Home Depot U.S.A., Inc. for maintenance, repair, and operations supplies
12 and miscellaneous materials on an as-needed basis, of the same kind identified in the
13 Maricopa County Contract in an annual amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) with a
14 twenty percent (20%) contingency of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000), for a
15 total annual not to exceed amount of One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
16 (\$1,200,000), until Maricopa County Contract No. Serial 16154-RFP expires on December
17 31, 2026, with the option to renew for as long as Maricopa County Contract No. Serial
18 16154-RFP is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

19 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
20 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
