#### RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit, with conditions, on the application of LJB Bishop Enterprises, Inc., DBA Shore Ultra Lounge, 6400 E. Pacific Coast Hwy., for Entertainment With Dancing by Patrons at an existing Bar/Tavern/Lounge. (District 3)

#### DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the application is complete and truthful; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved, a short-term permit shall be approved, or the application shall be denied.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) grant a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit, with or without conditions; or, 3) deny the Permit on the application.

Attached for your review is the application from LJB Bishop Enterprises, Inc., DBA Shore Ultra Lounge. Also attached are reports from various departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the license history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to conditions.
- The Fire Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved as a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or license are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a Bar/Tavern/Lounge since March 2004.

This item was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on June 17, 2009.

#### **TIMING CONSIDERATIONS**

The hearing date of July 7, 2009, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$20 and Zoning Review \$14 (Development Services Department), Police Investigation \$1,060 (Police Department), and Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$309.77 and Regulatory \$930 (Financial Management Department).

#### **Recommended Conditions of Operation**

## LJB Bishop Enterprises, Inc., DBA Shore Ultra Lounge, 6400 E. Pacific Coast Hwy Application for Entertainment with Dancing

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 21.15.110 LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Shore Ultra Lounge shall not advertise, procure, nor allow any person, performance, show, wet t-shirt contest, promotion, or any other event or entertainment that exposes or promotes, encourages, or allows the exposure of the male or female genitals, cleft of the buttocks, the areola or any portion of the female breast below the areola, while at or inside the business.
- 4) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to the hours of starting at 10:00 AM and closing at 2:00 AM each day of the week.
- 5) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the licensee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time. (LBMC section 18.48.320)
- No owner, operator or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years within the premises at any time during the hours of operation.
- 7) There shall be no outdoor entertainment allowed at any time.
- 8) Noise emanating from the Permittee's premises shall not be audible 50 feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The Permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment or by offering non-amplified entertainment.
- 9) During any entertainment activity listed on page #5 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty

people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Shore Ultra Lounge employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.

- 10) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 11) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 12) All promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License <u>prior to</u> conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters.
- 13) The permittee must provide all promoters hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.
- 14) Shore Ultra Lounge, its promoters, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter, such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection at anytime.
- 15) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.

- 17) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee(s) shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 18) The licensee shall ensure that shipping and/or receiving activities occur only between 8 AM and 10 PM.
- 19) The licensee shall ensure that outside trash and refuse containers are serviced by sanitation companies only between 8AM and 10PM
- 20) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 PM and 8 AM
- 21) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80)
- 22) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.
- 23) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control.
- 26) No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of licensee.
- 27) There shall be no exterior advertising promoting or indicating the availability of alcoholic beverages.
- The permittee shall not allow any employee, patron or entertainer, to exit or loiter adjacent to the business or on East Marina Drive and/or East Pacific Coast Highway, after 10 PM, with exception of an emergency. The permittee and/or security shall also ensure that no employee, patron, or entertainer loiters in the parking lots adjacent to the business (both sides of East Marina Drive and/or East Pacific Coast Highway), ensuring that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles and not loiter in the parking lots or the immediate area.
- 29) Between the hours of 8 PM. and a half hour after closing on Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays and as needed, the petitioner(s) shall provide one (1) security guard in the parking lots adjacent to the business and shall maintain order therein and prevent any activity, which would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of their property by nearby residents. Said personnel shall be clothed in such a manner as to be readily identifiable as security.
- 30) The permittee, shall maintain security cameras at all entrances and facades of the building. Recorded video shall be viewable upon request.







In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment with Dancing, the Police Department recommends approval, subject to the following seventeen (17) standard conditions:

Sachi Bar is a nightclub/bar located inside the Seaport Marina Hotel. The business has been in operation since November of 2005, and had a valid entertainment permit. The business was recently purchased by LJB Bishop Enterprises, and was required to re-apply for an entertainment permit. Based on the Police Department's investigation and the East Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, the Long Beach Police Department does not believe the issuance of an Entertainment Permit with Dancing will have an adverse impact on Patrol Division resources.

#### CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 21.15.110 LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Sachi shall not advertise, procure, nor allow any person, performance, show, wet t-shirt contest, promotion, or any other event or entertainment that exposes or promotes, encourages, or allows the exposure of the male or female genitals, cleft of the buttocks, the areola or any portion of the female breast below the areola, while at or inside the business.
- 4) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to the hours of starting at 10:00 AM and closing at 2:00 AM each day of the week.
- 5) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the licensee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time. (LBMC section 18.48.320)

The Permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment or by offering non-amplified entertainment.
- 9) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Sachi employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.
- 11) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 12) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
