A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF THE CALIFORNIA MUNICIPAL FINANCE AUTHORITY REVENUE BONDS (RETIREMENT HOUSING FOUNDATION OBLIGATED GROUP) SERIES 2017 IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$37,000,000; APPROVAL OF THE TEFRA HEARING RELATED TO THE ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS; AND CERTAIN OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO

WHEREAS, Bixby Knolls Towers, Inc., Gold Country Health Center, Inc., Mayflower RHF Housing, Inc., Mayflower Gardens Health Facility, Inc., and Sun City RHF Housing, Inc. (collectively, the "Borrowers"), each a nonprofit public benefit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), have requested that the California Municipal Finance Authority (the "Authority") participate in the issuance of one or more series of revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$37,000,000 (the "Bonds") the proceeds of which will be used to: (1) current refund the California Statewide Communities Development Authority Revenue Bonds (Retirement Housing Foundation Obligated Group), Series 2014A, (2) finance or reimburse the costs of constructing, renovating, remodeling and/or equipping long-term care facilities located on the Borrower's campuses in an amount not to exceed \$7,000,000, (3) fund a debt service reserve fund to secure the Bonds and (4) pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, Bixby Knolls Towers, Inc. owns and operates two mid-rise buildings, known as Bixby Knolls Towers and Bixby Knolls Health Care & Rehabilitation

Center, that include 168 residential apartments, 54 assisted living units and 99 skilled nursing beds (the "Facilities"), located within the City of Long Beach (the "City"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Code, the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority must be approved by the City because the Facilities are located within the territorial limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City (the "Council") is the elected legislative body of the City and is one of the applicable elected representatives required to approve the issuance of the Bonds under Section 147(f) of the Code; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has requested that the Council approve the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority in order to satisfy the public approval requirement of Section 147(f) of the Code and the requirements of the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement Relating to the California Municipal Finance Authority, dated as of January 1, 2004 (the "Agreement"), among certain local agencies, including the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Code, the City Treasurer has, on behalf of the Council and following notice duly given, held a public hearing regarding the issuance of the Bonds, and the Council now desires to approve the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The Council hereby approves the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority. It is the purpose and intent of the Council that this resolution constitute approval of the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority, for the purposes of (a) Section 147(f) of the Code by the applicable elected representative of the issuer of the Bonds and the governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which the Facilities are located, in accordance with said Section 147(f), and (b) the Agreement.

The officers of the City are hereby authorized and directed, Section 2. jointly and severally, to do any and all things and to execute and deliver any and all documents which they deem necessary or advisable in order to carry out, give effect to
