CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER AUTHORIZATION NO. 12 (Vault adjustment- Stripping-Pipe CB- Slurry & Red Paint - Meter Connection)

PART 1 (Reason for Change)

- Change Order was required because existing vault adjustment was not included in the 1.1 bid item.
- Change Order was required because removal of the existing and scrambled crosswalk 1.2 were not part of the original drawing.
- Change Order was required because the existing pipe connected to the existing CB was not shown the drawing and the Contractor was directed to extend the pipe and keep the pipe in place after existing CB removal.
- Change Order was required because Slurry 8' x 175' WB Lane and Prep and Paint Red on Walnut Ave north of 20th Ave was not part of the original design.
- Change Order was required because reconnection of the LBCC water maters behind the meter after the relocation was not part of this project.

PART 2 (Description of Change)

- Provide all labor, materials and equipment to reconstruct Vault top section including excavate area around vault, remove frame and cover, form top section and pour concrete top section & AC patch.
- Provide all labor, materials and equipment to strip the thermo line work & crosswalks and removals of the existing on Walnut and 20th
- 2.3 Provide all labor, materials and equipment to connect pipe to pipe after the existing CB removal.
- 2.4 Provide all labor, materials and equipment to Slurry 8' x 175' WB Lane and Prep and Paint Red on Walnut Ave north of 20th Ave.
- Provide all labor, materials and equipment to reconnect the LBCC's water meters located in 20th Ave.
