A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH FASTENAL COMPANY ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA THROUGH OMNIA PARTNERS, IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$225,000

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with other government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase fasteners, miscellaneous hardware, and heating, ventilation and air-conditioning parts and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the University of California through Omnia Partners has a contract with Fastenal Company for maintenance repair and operations supplies and related services, Purchasing Agreement No. 2018.000208 ("UC Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the UC Agreement will facilitate acquisition of the fasteners, miscellaneous hardware, and heating, ventilation and airconditioning parts and supplies as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the UC Agreement considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter a

contract with Fastenal Company for fasteners, miscellaneous hardware, and heating,		
ventilation and air-conditioning parts and supplies, in an annual amount of Two Hundred		
Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$225,000), for a period of three (3) years, with the option		
to renew for as long as the Omnia Partners Contract is in effect, and at the discretion of		
the City Manager.		
Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption		
by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
