



In accordance with Procedures for changes in the work as established in the specifications, you are authorized to do the following:

Establish a new bid item to provide all necessary labor, material and equipment to remove and replace the existing traffic signal poles located at the intersections of Windward Drive, Arlington Street and 34th Street on Santa Fe Avenue per Delta 3 drawings as agreed by the Project Engineer,

Provide all labor, equipment and material to install additional traffic detector loops as necessary at the intersection of Spring Street, 32nd Street, and Windward Drive on Santa Fe Avenue As agreed by the Project Engineer,

In accordance with Section 3-3, Extra work of the standard Specifications for Public Works Construction, 2009 Edition, you are authorized to do the following:

3.	Provide all labor, equipment and material necessary to remove bus stop bulb outs and modify existing gutters at 34th street, Windward Drive, and Lincoln Avenue on Santa Fe Avenue per delta drawings 1, 2 As agreed by the Project Engineer, For the estimated cost of	11,652.74
4.	Provide all labor, equipment and material necessary for additional traffic control required for Delta 1, 2 hardscape revisions, delta 3 traffic signal revisions, Delta drawing 4 curb paint revisions and added tree trimming in the center median along Santa Fe Avenue, as agreed by the Project Engineer, For the estimated cost of	11,671.26
5.	Provide all labor, equipment and material necessary to repair an existing (DLC) detector locator conductor crossing at the intersection of 34th street, and install new DLC between Cameron Street to Wardlow Road on Santa Fe Avenue As agreed by the Project Engineer, For the estimated cost of	20,111.24

6. Furnish all labor, material and equipment necessary to remove and replace curb paint and thermoplastic traffic stop bars located east and west bound on Cameron Street, Lincoln Avenue, and Arlington Street and Santa Fe Avenue per Delta 4 traffic paint revisions As agreed by the Project Engineer,

Furnish all labor, material and equipment necessary to repair one damaged and unmarked street light conduit located on the west side of Santa Fe Avenue at 32nd Street, As agreed by the Project Engineer, For the estimated cost of \$

TOTAL ESTIMATED INCREASE TO CONTRACT COST \$ 86,309.70

By signing this change order the Contractor acknowledges that it is familiar with California Civil Code Section 1542, which reads: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor;" and Contractor hereby releases the City from any unknown claims and waives its rights under Section 1542.

The prices set forth herein above shall be considered full compensation for all obligations of the contractor associated with this change order, and the City will not be liable for any claim of the contractor for delays or extra compensation resulting from performance of the requirements of this change order.

TIME FOR COMPLETION OF ALL WORK UNDER THE CONTRACT WILL BE EXTENDED FIVE DAYS BEYOND EXECUTION BY THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS.
