RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to declare ordinance amending the Long Beach Municipal Code by amending Sections 8.63.020, 8.63.030, 8.63.050 and 8.63.070; all relating to prohibiting the use and sale of single-use food and beverage containers, packaging and food service ware made of expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam, rigid polystyrene #6, and non-recyclable and non-compostable material for prepared food distribution, and the distribution of plastic for bio-plastic straws, read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of the City Council for final reading. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

Pursuant to your requests on October 15, 2019 and February 4, 2020, this ordinance has been prepared and is submitted for your consideration.

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8.63.020 Definitions.

A. "Applicant" means any individual, firm, limited liability company, association, partnership, political subdivision, government agency, municipality, industry, public or private corporation, or any other entity whatsoever who applies for a City of Long Beach special events permit or an exemption to the requirements of this Chapter.

B. "City facility" means any building, structure, property, park or open space owned, managed or leased by the City, its agents, agencies, or departments. This includes, but is not limited to, the Queen Mary, the Convention Center, the Aquarium, and the Long Beach Airport.

C. "City contractor" means any person who enters into an agreement with the City to furnish products or services to or for the City.

D. "City-permitted event" means any event, activity or meeting occurring under the auspices of a City-issued permit.

E. "City-sponsored event" means any event, activity or meeting organized or sponsored, in whole or in part, by the City or any department of the City.

F. "Compostable" means all the material in the product or package will break down, or otherwise become part of, usable compost (e.g., soil-conditioning material, mulch) in a safe and timely manner. Compostable material must be made of paper, certified compostable plastics that meet ASTM D6400 or ASTM D6868 for compostability or cellulose-based packaging capable of being decomposed through composting or anaerobic digestion.

G. "Department" means the ~~D~~e~~p~~artment of Public Works.

H. "Director" means the Director of the ~~e~~D~~e~~partment of Public Works, or his/her designee, who is hereby designated to issue a compliance order or an administrative citation to enforce this Chapter

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1 pursuant to Chapters 1.25 or 1.26, respectively, of the Long Beach  
2 Municipal Code or to grant an exemption to compliance with this Chapter  
3 pursuant to Section 8.63.050.

4 I. "Disposable food service ware" or "disposables" means  
5 single-use, disposable products used for serving or transporting prepared  
6 food, including but not limited to plates, bowls, trays, wrappers or wrapping,  
7 platters, cartons, clamshells, condiment containers, cups or drink ware, ~~cup~~  
8 ~~lids~~, or any other container in or on which prepared foods are placed or  
9 packaged for consumption. This does not include ~~straws, cup-lids, or~~  
10 ~~utensils, nor does it include packaging for unprepared foods.~~

11 J. "Food Provider" means any person or place, other than a  
12 "Small Food Provider," that provides or sells prepared food within the City to  
13 the general public to be consumed on the premises or for take-away  
14 consumption. "Food Provider" includes but is not limited to: (1) a grocery  
15 store, supermarket, restaurant, drive-thru, cafe, coffee shop, snack shop,  
16 public food market, farmers market, convenience store, or similar fixed  
17 place where prepared food is available for sale on the premises or for take-  
18 away consumption, and (2) any mobile store, food vendor, caterer, food  
19 truck, vending machine or similar mobile outlet. "Food Provider" also  
20 includes any Franchise restaurant, drive-thru, café, coffee-shop or the like.  
21 "Food Provider" also includes any organization, group or individual that  
22 regularly provides prepared food to its members or the general public as a  
23 part of its activities or services.

24 K. "Franchise" means a food facility in the City that operates  
25 under common ownership or control with at least ~~fifteen (15)~~ other food  
26 facilities with the same name that offer for sale substantially the same menu  
27 items, or operates as a franchised outlet of a parent company with at least  
28 ~~fifteen (15)~~ other franchised outlets with the same name in the state that

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1 offer for sale substantially the same menu items.

2 L. "Small Food Provider" means a person or place that provides  
3 or sells prepared food within the City to the general public to be consumed  
4 on the premises or for take-away consumption, seating one hundred (100)  
5 or fewer persons.

6 M. "Person" means any person, business, corporation, or event  
7 organizer or promoter; public, nonprofit or private entity, agency or  
8 institution; or partnership, association or other organization or group,  
9 however organized.

10 M.N. "Plastic or Bio-Plastic straw" means a tube made  
11 predominantly of plastic derived from either petroleum or biologically based  
12 polymer, such as corn or plant sources, for transferring a beverage from its  
13 container to the mouth of the drinker. This includes compostable and  
14 biodegradable petroleum or biologically based polymer straws, but does not  
15 include straws that are made from non-plastic materials, such as paper,  
16 sugarcane, bamboo, etc.

17 N.O. "Polystyrene" means a thermoplastic petrochemical material  
18 utilizing the styrene monomer, including but not limited to polystyrene foam  
19 or expanded polystyrene, processed by any number of techniques,  
20 including but not limited to fusion of polymer spheres (expandable bead  
21 polystyrene), injection molding, foam molding, or extrusion-blow molding  
22 (extruded foam polystyrene), and clear or solid polystyrene (oriented  
23 polystyrene). The recycle code for polystyrene is "6" or "PS," either alone or  
24 in combination with other letters. This definition applies to all polystyrene  
25 food service ware, regardless of whether it exhibits a recycle code.

26 O.P. "Polystyrene Beads" means expanded polystyrene foam  
27 beads used as filler for toys and beanbags and in crafts.

28 P.Q. "Polystyrene Cooler" means any cooler or ice chest made of



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1 polystyrene foam, where such foam is not fully encased in a durable  
2 material.

3 Q.R. "Polystyrene food service ware" means disposable food  
4 service ware that contains or utilizes polystyrene. This includes but is not  
5 limited to cups, cup lids, condiment cups, food trays, plates, bowls,  
6 clamshells and any other product made primarily for food service use.

7 R.S. "Prepared food" means any food or beverage that is: (1) ready  
8 to consume without any further food preparation, alteration or repackaging;  
9 and (2) prepared, provided, sold or served by a fFood pProvider using any  
10 cooking, packaging or food preparation technique. Prepared food may be  
11 eaten either on or off the Food pProvider's premises. Prepared food does  
12 not include: (1) any raw uncooked meat, poultry, fish or eggs, unless  
13 provided for consumption without further food preparation; and (2) fresh  
14 produce provided for consumption without food preparation or repackaging,  
15 including fruits, vegetables, and herbs, sold by grocery stores,  
16 supermarkets, food markets, farmers markets and other food vendors.

17 S.T. "Recyclable" means material that can be sorted, cleansed and  
18 reconstituted using the City's available Residential Recycling Program  
19 excluding Plastic containers labeled #6 and any Polystyrene.

20 T.U. "Recycle code" means a resin identification code placed on  
21 plastics to identify the material composition for separation of different types  
22 of plastics for recycling.

23 U.V. "Special events" means events that are open to the general  
24 public and take place within the public right-of-way or are located within a  
25 park and/or are coordinated through the City of Long Beach's special  
26 events permit process.

27 V.W. "Utensil" means a knife, fork, spoon, spork, chopstick, or the  
28 like, used for eating food.

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- 1           8.63.030     Prohibition against distribution or sale of polystyrene food service  
2                     ware.
- 3                 A.     No Food Provider shall distribute or sell any polystyrene food  
4                     service ware in conjunction with the sale of prepared food or beverages at  
5                     any location within the City of Long Beach.
- 6                 B.     Food Providers that distribute prepared food or beverages in  
7                     disposable food service ware shall: (1) distribute only disposables that are  
8                     either Recyclable or Compostable, and if plastic, exhibit a recycle code  
9                     other than No. 6 or PS; and/or (2) maintain documentation about the  
10                    composition of any disposable food service ware that does not exhibit a  
11                    recycle code. Documentation may include information from the supplier or  
12                    manufacturer, bulk packaging for the disposables, and any other relevant  
13                    information demonstrating that the disposable material is not polystyrene  
14                    and is either Recyclable or Compostable.
- 15                C.     No person shall distribute or sell prepared food or beverages  
16                    in any polystyrene food service ware at City facilities that have been rented,  
17                    leased or are otherwise being used with permission of the City. If  
18                    disposables are distributed or sold, they shall be either Recyclable or  
19                    Compostable. This Subsection is limited to use of City facilities for which a  
20                    person has entered into an agreement with the City to rent, lease or  
21                    otherwise occupy a City facility. All facility rental agreements for any City  
22                    facility shall include a provision requiring contracting parties to assume  
23                    responsibility for preventing the utilization and/or distribution of polystyrene  
24                    food service ware while using City facilities. The facility rental agreement  
25                    shall indicate that a violating contractor's security deposit will be forfeited if  
26                    the Director determines that polystyrene food service ware or disposables  
27                    that are neither Recyclable nor Compostable was used in violation of the  
28                    rental agreement.

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1 D. No person shall use or distribute polystyrene food service  
2 ware at City-sponsored events, activities and City meetings open to the  
3 public. This Subsection shall apply to the function organizers, agents of the  
4 organizers, City contractors, and Food Providers.

5 E. The City, its departments, its City contractors, agents, and  
6 employees acting in their official capacity, shall not purchase, acquire or  
7 distribute for public use any polystyrene food service ware or disposables  
8 that are neither Recyclable nor Compostable, or Polystyrene Coolers.

9 F. All Food Providers shall certify compliance with this Chapter  
10 as part of the Environmental Health inspection process.

11 G. No person, vendor, business or event promoter in the City  
12 may sell, rent or otherwise provide any polystyrene food service ware  
13 product which is not wholly encapsulated or encased within a more durable  
14 material, except as exempted herein. This specifically includes, but is not  
15 limited to, cups, cup lids, condiment cups, food trays, plates, bowls,  
16 clamshells and other products primarily for food service use, as well as  
17 Polystyrene Coolers and ice chests.

18 H. No person, vendor, business or event promoter in the City  
19 shall sell, distribute, or otherwise provide polystyrene packing material,  
20 including, but not limited to, foam peanuts, packing peanuts, foam popcorn  
21 or packing noodles.

22 F.I. No person, vendor, business or event promoter may sell, rent,  
23 or otherwise distribute within the City meat and fish trays, produce trays or  
24 egg cartons made, in whole or in part, from polystyrene, either as separate  
25 items or as part of the sale of meat, fish, poultry, vegetables, fruit, or eggs  
26 sold to consumers.

27 G.J. Straws and Uutensils for take-away foods shall only be  
28 provided upon customer request at all food establishments, including at City

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1 facilities. All straws must not be plastic or bio-plastic straws.

2  
3 8.63.050 Exemption from compliance with this Chapter.

4 A. The following are exempt from the provisions of this Chapter:

5 1. Food prepared or packaged outside of the City,  
6 provided such food is not altered, packaged or repackaged within the City  
7 limits.

8 2. Coolers and ice chests, other than those defined as  
9 Polystyrene Coolers in this Chapter.

10 3. Food brought by individuals for personal consumption  
11 to City facilities, including but not limited to City parks, provided the City  
12 facility is being used for individual recreation or similar purposes and such  
13 facility use is not part of a larger organized event requiring a special events  
14 permit from the City.

15 4. City-sponsored or City-permitted events for which  
16 authorizations or permits were issued prior to the operative date of this  
17 ordinance; except events for which multi-year authorizations or permits  
18 were issued, which must comply within three hundred sixty-five (365) days  
19 of the operative date of this ordinance.

20 5. Emergency supplies and services. During a locally  
21 declared emergency, the City, emergency response agencies operating  
22 within the City, users of City facilities, and Food Providers and beverage  
23 providers shall be exempt from the provisions of this Chapter.

24 5.6. The Food Provider or beverage provider provides or  
25 distributes a plastic beverage straw upon request to individuals with  
26 disabilities as needed to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

27 B. Food Providers that are obligated to purchase or have  
28 purchased polystyrene food service ware under a contract entered into



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1 within the year prior to the operative date of this ordinance are exempt from  
2 the provisions of this Chapter for six (6) months following its operative date.

3 C. The Director may exempt any person from Section 8.63.030  
4 following the operative date of this ordinance, as follows:

5 1. A request for an exemption shall be filed in writing with  
6 the Director and shall include documentation of the reason for the claimed  
7 exemption and any other information necessary for the department to make  
8 its decision. The department may require the Applicant to provide additional  
9 information as necessary to make the required determinations.

10 2. The Director may grant an exemption for a maximum of  
11 one (1) year, with or without conditions, upon finding that compliance would  
12 create an undue hardship. Applications for exemption renewals will also be  
13 considered. Undue hardship shall be construed to include but not be limited  
14 to situations where:

15 a. There are no reasonable alternatives to  
16 polystyrene food service ware for reasons that are unique to the Applicant;  
17 or

18 b. Compliance with the requirements of this  
19 Chapter would deprive a person of a legally protected right.

20 3. The Director's written decision on the exemption is  
21 effective within ten (10) days of the decision. Decisions of the Director may  
22 be appealed by the person applying for the exemption utilizing the process  
23 outlined in Section 8.63.080.

24  
25 8.63.070 Operative date.

26 A. No City facilities, City contractors, City-sponsored events or  
27 City-permitted events shall distribute or utilize disposable food service ware  
28 containing polystyrene on or after three (3) months following the adoption of

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1 the ordinance codified in this Chapter by the City Council. City-sponsored or  
2 City-permitted events for which authorizations or permits were issued prior  
3 to the operative date of this Ordinance are exempt as provided in  
4 Subsection 8.63.050.A.4. City-sponsored or City-permitted events which  
5 are authorized or permitted for multiple years must comply within three  
6 hundred sixty-five (365) days of the operative of this ordinance.

7 B. No Food Provider shall distribute or utilize disposable food  
8 service ware containing polystyrene on or after nine (9) months following  
9 the operative date of the ordinance codified in this Chapter by the City  
10 Council.

11 C. No Small Food Provider shall distribute or utilize disposable  
12 food service ware containing polystyrene on or after eighteen (18) months  
13 following the operative date of the ordinance codified in this Chapter by the  
14 City Council.

15 D. No person shall sell or distribute Polystyrene Beads for crafts  
16 or as filler for bean bags, or Polystyrene Coolers on or after October 1,  
17 2020~~or after eighteen (18) months following the adoption of the ordinance~~  
18 ~~codified in this Chapter by the City Council.~~

19 D.E. The prohibition against retail sales contained in Section  
20 8.63.030 (G), (H) and (I) shall be effective on or after October 1, 2020.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 8.63.020, 8.63.030, 8.63.050 AND 8.63.070; ALL RELATING TO PROHIBITING THE USE AND SALE OF SINGLE-USE FOOD AND BEVERAGE CONTAINERS, PACKAGING AND FOOD SERVICE WARE MADE OF EXPANDED POLYSTYRENE (EPS) FOAM, RIGID POLYSTYRENE #6, AND NON-RECYCLABLE AND NON-COMPOSTABLE MATERIAL FOR PREPARED FOOD DISTRIBUTION, AND THE DISTRIBUTION OF PLASTIC OR BIO-PLASTIC STRAWS

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 8.63.020 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

8.63.020 Definitions.

A. "Applicant" means any individual, firm, limited liability company, association, partnership, political subdivision, government agency, municipality, industry, public or private corporation, or any other entity whatsoever who applies for a City of Long Beach special events permit or an exemption to the requirements of this Chapter.

B. "City facility" means any building, structure, property, park or open space owned, managed or leased by the City, its agents, agencies, or departments. This includes, but is not limited to, the Queen Mary, the

1 Convention Center, the Aquarium, and the Long Beach Airport.

25 food, including but not limited to plates, bowls, trays, wrappers or wrapping,  
26 platters, cartons, clamshells, condiment containers, cups or drink ware, cup  
27 lids, or any other container in or on which prepared foods are placed or  
28 packaged for consumption. This does not include utensils.



1           J.       “Food Provider” means any person or place, other than a

11 or otherwise distribute within the City meat and fish trays, produce trays or  
12 egg cartons made, in whole or in part, from polystyrene, either as separate  
13 items or as part of the sale of meat, fish, poultry, vegetables, fruit, or eggs  
14 sold to consumers.

15 J. Straws and utensils shall only be provided upon customer  
16 request at all food establishments, including at City facilities. All straws  
17 must not be plastic or bio-plastic straws.

18  
19 Section 3. Section 8.63.050 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is  
20 amended to read as follows:

21 8.63.050 Exemption from compliance with this Chapter:

22 A. The following are exempt from the provisions of this Chapter:

23 1. Food prepared or packaged outside of the City,  
24 provided such food is not altered, packaged or repackaged within the City  
25 limits.

26 2. Coolers and ice chests, other than those defined as  
27 Polystyrene Coolers in this Chapter.

28 3. Food brought by individuals for personal consumption

1 to City facilities, including but not limited to City parks, provided the City  
2 facility is being used for individual recreation or similar purposes and such  
3 facility use is not part of a larger organized event requiring a special events  
4 permit from the City.

5 4. City-sponsored or City-permitted events for which  
6 authorizations or permits were issued prior to the operative date of this  
7 ordinance; except events for which multi-year authorizations or permits  
8 were issued, which must comply within three hundred sixty-five (365) days  
9 of the operative date of this ordinance.

10 5. During a locally declared emergency, the City,  
11 emergency response agencies operating within the City, users of City  
12 facilities, and Food Providers and beverage providers shall be exempt from  
13 the provisions of this Chapter.

14 6. The Food Provider or beverage provider provides or  
15 distributes a plastic beverage straw upon request to individuals with  
16 disabilities as needed to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

17 B. Food Providers that are obligated to purchase or have  
18 purchased polystyrene food service ware under a contract entered into  
19 within the year prior to the operative date of this ordinance are exempt from  
20 the provisions of this Chapter for six (6) months following its operative date.

21 C. The Director may exempt any person from Section 8.63.030  
22 following the operative date of this ordinance, as follows:

23 1. A request for an exemption shall be filed in writing with  
24 the Director and shall include documentation of the reason for the claimed  
25 exemption and any other information necessary for the department to make  
26 its decision. The department may require the Applicant to provide additional  
27 information as necessary to make the required determinations.

28 2. The Director may grant an exemption for a maximum of

1 one (1) year, with or without conditions, upon finding that compliance would  
2 create an undue hardship. Applications for exemption renewals will also be  
3 considered. Undue hardship shall be construed to include but not be limited  
4 to situations where:

5 a. There are no reasonable alternatives to  
6 polystyrene food service ware for reasons that are unique to the Applicant;  
7 or

8 b. Compliance with the requirements of this  
9 Chapter would deprive a person of a legally protected right.

10 3. The Director's written decision on the exemption is  
11 effective within ten (10) days of the decision. Decisions of the Director may  
12 be appealed by the person applying for the exemption utilizing the process  
13 outlined in Section 8.63.080.

14  
15 Section 4. Section 8.63.070 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 8.63.070 Operative date.

18 A. No City facilities, City contractors, City-sponsored events or  
19 City-permitted events shall distribute or utilize disposable food service ware  
20 containing polystyrene on or after three (3) months following the adoption of  
21 the ordinance codified in this Chapter by the City Council. City-sponsored or  
22 City-permitted events for which authorizations or permits were issued prior  
23 to the operative date of this Ordinance are exempt as provided in  
24 Subsection 8.63.050.A.4. City-sponsored or City-permitted events which  
25 are authorized or permitted for multiple years must comply within three  
26 hundred sixty-five (365) days of the operative of this ordinance.

27 B. No Food Provider shall distribute or utilize disposable food  
28 service ware containing polystyrene on or after nine (9) months following

1 the operative date of the ordinance codified in this Chapter by the City  
2 Council.

3 C. No Small Food Provider shall distribute or utilize disposable  
4 food service ware containing polystyrene on or after eighteen (18) months  
5 following the operative date of the ordinance codified in this Chapter by the  
6 City Council.

7 D. No person shall sell or distribute Polystyrene Beads for crafts  
8 or as filler for bean bags, or Polystyrene Coolers on or after October 1,  
9 2020.

10 E. The prohibition against retail sales contained in Section  
11 8.63.030 (G), (H) and (I) shall be effective on or after October 1, 2020.

12  
13 Section 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by  
14 the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of  
15 Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the  
16 Mayor.
