#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the public hearing, and grant an Entertainment Permit with conditions on the application of Shore Restaurant Group, LLC, dba Legends Sports Bar, at 5236 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, for Entertainment without Dancing. (District 3)

#### DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit (Permit) is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires the City Council to approve the issuance of the Permit if they find that: the issuance of the Permit at the proposed location is consistent with federal, state and local laws, rules, and regulations; it will not constitute an undue burden on the neighborhood; the applicant(s) or responsible persons have not been convicted of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or felony offense within the past five years; and, neither the applicant(s) nor any responsible persons have a history of committing significant violations of the City code and have not provided false or misleading information on their application.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: (1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or (2) deny the Permit on the application. Once the Permit is granted, pursuant to LBMC 5.72.120.5, the Permit will be subject to an administrative review by the Financial Management Department every two years. This review process will consist of a multi-department analysis to determine compliance and identify if issues exist. This provision does not affect the City's ability to modify, revoke, or suspend a permit at any time.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached are the departmental investigative reports, history, entertainment permit application, and floor plan.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

- The Police Department recommends the permit for entertainment without dancing be approved, subject to conditions.
- The Fire Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.
- The Health and Human Services Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use, subject to conditions.
- The Development Services Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

The Financial Management Department, Business Services Bureau, has thoroughly reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence, and recommends the permit for entertainment without dancing be approved, subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions are in conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee must adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a Restaurant with Alcohol since August 1988.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy R. Webber on March 4, 2020.

#### TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of April 14, 2020, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review Fee (\$23.30), Zoning Review Fee (\$33), Police Investigation Fee (\$1,410), and Mailing List Fee (\$90).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License Annual Tax (\$379.07), Employee Rate Tax (\$19.68 per employee), and Annual Entertainment Regulatory Fee (\$334). Fee and tax revenues are collected in multiple departments and funds.

# Recommended Conditions of Operation Shore Restaurant Group LLC DBA Legends Sports Bar 5236 2<sup>nd</sup> St Application for Entertainment Without Dancing

The Department of Financial Management recommends **approval** of the Permit subject to the following conditions:

#### I. STANDARD CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LMBC Chapter 8.80).
- 4) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction. Outdoor amplified entertainment is prohibited.
- The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) licensed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 6) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.
- 7) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the front of the establishment, the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 8) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City for all costs associated with excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 9) All promoters and independent contractors must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters or independent contractors.
- 10) The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and dancers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permits, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation. The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- 11) The business, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.
- 12) The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-ways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.

- 13) An identification card scanner shall be used for all patrons entering the establishment after 10:00 PM for the sole purpose of verifying patron age and/or authenticity of a patron's driver's license or identification card.
- 14) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 15) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320).
- 16) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, your conditional use permit, or your Alcoholic Beverage Control license, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 17) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.
- 18) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors" or something similar.
- 19) If the permittee utilizes an independent third party event promoter to provide entertainment related services resulting in any public safety call for service, the City reserves the right to remove and/or restrict the use of independent third party promoters.
- 20) The permittee shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premises over which they have control.
- 21) The permittee shall ensure that all employees attend an alcohol awareness class such as TIPS or LEAD, within the first ninety (90) days of employment. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety-day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be kept on file at the business and shall be available for inspection at any time.



#### II. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) Entertainment activities indicated on Page 9 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 10:00 PM, Sunday through Wednesday, and 12:00 AM (Midnight), Thursday through Saturday.
- 2) The permittee shall ensure that a security guard monitor and check the alley and rear parking lots behind the establishment every 30-minutes after 8:00 PM, each night of the week. Security shall maintain order and prevent the unlawful consumption of alcohol. Security shall prevent any activity that would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of any nearby residential property.
- This Entertainment Permit is an accessory to the primary business. The authorization to provide entertainment on-site is subject to the use remaining a bona fide eating place serving actual and substantial meals. "Meals" means the usual assortment of foods commonly ordered at various hours of the day; the service of such food only as sandwiches or salads shall not be deemed compliant with this requirement. Meals must consist of food prepared on the premises. Hours of sales of alcohol shall be limited to the hours when meals are available. The premises must be equipped and maintained in good faith. The premises must possess working refrigeration, cooking equipment, utensils, menus, and enough food to make substantial meals. In the event the primary business ceases operation, fails to operate as a bona fide eating place, fails to serve actual and substantial meals, or otherwise fails to comply with this condition, the Entertainment Permit becomes null and void.
- 4) The permittee shall develop and maintain a plan to address neighborhood concerns, related to the operation of the establishment (i.e. newsletter, meetings, etc.)
- 5) Interior lighting shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons inside the business.
- 6) The permittee shall not convert the restaurant, or any portion thereof, into a dance/night club. All entertainment activities shall be conducted in conjunction with regular dining or pre-planned banquet activities. A banquet is defined as a function held at a bonafide eating place wherein complete and substantial meals are provided to the persons in attendance by the management of the restaurant where the function is being held. Fast food, snacks, and hors d'oeuvres shall not constitute a complete and substantial meal.
- 7) Patrons awaiting in a defined "queue" shall be restricted to East 2<sup>nd</sup> Street <u>and</u> the line must extend west of the business. There shall be no "queue" allowed after 11:30 PM, each day of the week. All persons gathering outside after the

- allowed hours shall be considered to be loitering. The public right of way (sidewalk), or an entrance to any business shall not be blocked at any time.
- 8) During business hours the permittee shall not allow any employee, patron or entertainer, to exit or loiter near the rear door leading to the alley and the parking lot after 8:00 P.M., except in the case of an emergency.
- III. In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or license is in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. In addition, please be advised that your permit is subject to administrative review every two years from the date this permit is issued. If grounds exist for modification, revocation, or suspension of the permit, a hearing will be held.

Under the Long Beach Municipal Code (Section 3.80.210), any person operating a business in the City of Long Beach is required to obtain a

A business license is valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance (unless otherwise noted) and must be renewed each year. A renewal notice is sent to the licensee ten (10) days prior to the due date, and the licensee has thirty (30) days to pay without penalty. If a notice is not received by the licensee, he/she is still responsible for payment by the due date. If the licensee changes his/her mailing address during the

A penalty equivalent to twenty-five percent (25%) of the payment due applies to all delinquent licenses unpaid after thirty (30) days from the due date. An additional ten percent (10%) penalty is added on the first day of the calendar month following the imposition of the twenty-five percent (25%) penalty if the tax remains unpaid, up to a maximum of one hundred percent (100%) of the tax due. The postmark will govern the determination of whether or not a tax payment is delinquent. A delinquent tax will be deemed a debt to the City, and the licensee shall be

When more than one business activity is engaged in at the same location, and the activity falls into a classification other than that of the original license, the licensee is required to obtain an additional license for each different business activity. If the licensee has more than one business license at the same location, he/she may choose to pay for all employees on one license. If so, the licensee will pay for the

For the purpose of Business License taxation in the City of Long Beach, an employee is defined as: Every person engaged in the operation or conduct of any business in Long Beach, whether as owner, member of the owner's family, partner, associate, agent, manager or solicitor, and every person employed or working in such business, whether full-time, part-time, permanent or temporary, for a wage, salary, commission or

Apportionment of payment of tax (3.80.256)  For purposes of apportionment as may be required by law and for purposes of administration and enforcement of this Chapter, the Director may from time to time promulgate administrative rules and regulations for a business subject to the business license tax under this Chapter that can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Director that it will be doing business in the City for only a portion of a year.
Refunds Prior to Start of Business (L.B.M.C. 3.80.427.5.F)  Any application for refund must be made by the person entitled to the money within one year after payment of the money to the City. No refund shall be made of any moneys paid for the issuance or renewal of any license unless it is determined that such licensee has not engaged in, nor held himself out as being engaged in, such business or occupation at any time after the effective date of the license. The amount of the refund shall be the full amount of the license tax paid, less an amount determined by the Director of Financial Management, which shall cover the cost of investigation and issuance of the license.
Sales or Use Tax Sales or Use Tax may apply to your business activity. You may seek advice regarding the application of the tax to your business by visiting the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration website at <a href="https://www.edtfa.ca.gov">www.edtfa.ca.gov</a> .
Inspections (The business license application must be available on site at time of inspection).  When a business license inspection is scheduled, the business must be fully prepared to operate, and the business owner or operator must be on site for the entire scheduled time of inspection. If the business owner or operator is unprepared for or misses a scheduled business license inspection without giving a minimum of 24 hours notice to the appropriate City agency, a re-inspection fee will be assessed.

The licensee shall at all times maintain records which reflect separately the gross sale of food and the gross sales of alcoholic beverages of the licensed business. Said records shall be kept no

less frequently than on a quarterly basis and shall be made available to the Department on demand.

- The rear doors of the premises shall be equipped on the inside with an automatic locking device and shall be closed at all times, and shall not be used as a means of access by patrons to and from the licensed premises. - 4 Petitioner(s) shall police the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons about the premises as depicted on ABC-253, dated 11/23/11.

- 10 The licensee, or its agent or employee, shall remain at the entrance(s) door from 10:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. Thursday through Saturday.
- 11 Said employee shall affix a stamp on any patron's hand who enters the premises after 10:00 p.m.
- 12 The above conditions will be carried forward in any subsequent transfer at the applicant premises.





LEGENDS SPORTS BAR - 5236 EAST 2ND STREET

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment <u>without</u> Dancing, the Police Department recommends approval, subject to the following standard conditions of operation.

Legends Sports Bar is a bar located on the southwest corner of 2nd Street and Covina Avenue. The business took over ownership from Sports Legends Inc., in December 2011. The current owner for the business is Shore Restaurant Group LLC. Legends Sports Bar currently holds a Type 47 (On-Sale General Eating Place) and a Type 58 (Caterers Permit) Alcoholic Beverage Control License. This will be a new entertainment permit for the location and establishment. Legends Sports Bar applied for an Entertainment without Dancing Permit requesting amplified music (live) and a disc jockey. They requested to provide entertainment from 12:00 PM to 10:00 PM Sunday through Wednesday, 12:00 PM to 12:00 AM Thursday and 12:00 PM to 1:15 AM Friday and Saturday.

Based upon the Vice Section's investigation, East Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, and the crime analysis, the Long Beach Police Department has determined the public's peace, safety, and welfare would not be adversely impacted by the issuance of this permit, provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant. The Police Department recommends approval of an Entertainment without Dancing Permit.

#### **CONDITIONS OF OPERATION**

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 21.15.110 LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 12:00 AM (Midnight) Thursday through Saturday and 10:00 PM Sunday through Wednesday. Entertainment can begin at 7:00 PM on Monday through Friday. Entertainment can begin at 1:00 PM on Saturday and Sunday.

- 4) This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. The authorization to provide entertainment on-site is subject to the use remaining as a restaurant, meaning a bona fide eating place serving actual and substantial meals.
- "Meals" means the usual assortment of foods commonly ordered at various hours of the day; the service of such food only as sandwiches or salads shall not be deemed compliant with this requirement. Meals must consist of food prepared on the premises. Hours of sales of alcohol shall be limited to the hours when meals are available.

The premises must be equipped and maintained in good faith. The premises must possess working refrigeration, cooking equipment, utensils, menus, and enough food to make substantial meals.

In the event the primary business ceases operation, fails to operate as a bonafide eating place, fails to serve actual and substantial meals or otherwise fails to comply with this condition, the Entertainment Permit becomes null and void.

- The permittee shall not convert the restaurant, or any portion thereof, into a dance/night club. All entertainment activities shall be conducted in conjunction with regular dining or pre-planned banquet activities. A banquet is defined as a function held at a bonafide eating place wherein complete and substantial meals are provided to the persons in attendance by the management of the restaurant where the function is being held. Fast food, snacks, and hors d'oeuvres shall not constitute a complete and substantial meal.
- 7) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM
- 8) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City for all costs associated with excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations
- 9) The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-way's and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also

required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras

- 10) An identification card scanner shall be used for all patrons entering the establishment after 10:00 PM for the sole purpose of verifying patron age and/or authenticity of a patron's driver's license or identification card.
- 11) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request.
- Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency, and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible within fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction
- 14) The permittee shall develop and maintain a plan to address neighborhood concerns, related to the operation of Legends Sports Bar. (i.e. newsletter, meetings, etc.)
- The permittee shall not convert the restaurant, or any portion thereof, into a dance/night club. All entertainment activities shall be conducted in conjunction with **regular dining** or **pre-planned banquet activities**. A banquet is defined as a function held at a bonafide eating place wherein complete and substantial meals are provided to the persons in attendance by the management of the restaurant where the function is being held. Fast food, snacks, and hors d-oeuvres shall not constitute a complete and substantial meal.
- 16) The permittee shall ensure that all employees attend an alcohol awareness class, such as TIPS or LEAD, within the first ninety (90) days of employment. The permittee shall keep employees' proof of completion on file, and have it available for inspection at any time.

- 17) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 18) Outdoor amplified entertainment is prohibited.
- 19) Patrons awaiting entry in a defined "queue" shall be restricted to East 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and the line must extend east of the business. There shall be no "queue" allowed after 11:30 PM, each day of the week. All persons gathering outside after the allowed hours shall be considered to be loitering. The public right of way (sidewalk), or an entrance to any business shall not be blocked at any time.
- The permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and those waiting to enter. Potential patrons awaiting entry in a defined "queue" shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels. For crowds up to fifty (50) patrons, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) uniformed security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty patrons, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional uniformed security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Legends Sports Bar" employees. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot or adjacent property, the permittee shall increase security as directed by the Chief of Police.
- The permittee shall ensure that a security guard monitor and check the alley and rear parking lots behind the establishment every 30-minutes after 8:00 PM, each night of the week. Security shall maintain order and prevent the unlawful consumption of alcohol. Security shall prevent any activity that would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of any nearby residential property. Security guards must be identifiable as "Legend's Sports Bar" employees.
- The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times, while open for business. This should be done by utilizing security guards and signage with verbiage such as, "Please respect our neighbors," or something similar.
- 23) The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- 24) The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and dancers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the

- approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.
- Legends Sports Bar, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, any vehicle, or in any other such place in the City of Long Beach. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all agent contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.
- 26) The permittee shall not allow any employee, patron or entertainer, to exit or loiter near the rear door leading to the alley and the parking lot at any time during business hours.
- 27) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate neighboring area.

LEGENDS SPORTS BAR - 5236 EAST 2ND STREET

The Long Beach Police Department recommends approval of the application for an Entertainment without Dancing Permit, at Shore Restaurant Group LLC, dba Legends Sports Bar, located at 5236 East 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, subject to the conditions provided in the attached memorandum.

#### **Background**

Legends Sports Bar is a bar located on the southwest corner of 2nd Street and Covina Avenue. The business took over ownership from Sports Legends Inc., in December 2011. The current owner for the business is Shore Restaurant Group, LLC. Legends Sports Bar currently holds a Type 47 (On-Sale General Eating Place) and a Type 58 (Caterers Permit) Alcoholic Beverage Control License. This will be a new entertainment permit for the location and establishment. Legends Sports Bar applied for an Entertainment without Dancing Permit requesting amplified music (live) and a disc jockey. They requested to provide entertainment from 12:00 PM to 10:00 PM Sunday through Wednesday, 12:00 PM to 12:00 AM Thursday and 12:00 PM to 1:15 AM Friday and Saturday.

#### **Crime Analysis**

As part of the review process by the Long Beach Police Department, calls for service, crime reports, and arrests were evaluated at the above location for a two-year period between January 21, 2018 through January 21, 2020. There were sixteen calls for service, ten incidents reported, and three arrests attributable to the business. Ten calls for service were reported by the ownership and/or staff members.

#### **Patrol Division**

East Division Patrol Commander Pat O'Dowd was contacted for an opinion regarding the issuance of this permit. Commander O'Dowd said patrol has not had any problems with the establishment, and he is not opposed to the issuance of an Entertainment without Dancing Permit.

#### **Resident Contacts**

Vice Investigations contacted residents living within one hundred feet of the establishment. There are eight residences within this distance. The additional residents that responded were given the letter from nearby neighbors. One resident was not opposed to the issuance of an Entertainment without Dancing Permit.

There were seven residents **opposed** to the proposed entertainment activity. These residents explained that pedestrian traffic in the early morning hours is loud enough to wake them out of their sleep. They have woken up in the morning to find empty beer and liquor bottles in the front yard. They have been awakened in the middle of the night to patrons fighting in their front yard and damaging their property and vehicles.

The remaining five residents, within the one hundred feet, have not responded; a letter was mailed for them requesting they contact the Vice Investigations Section of the Long Beach Police Department.

#### Vice Investigation

As part of this investigation, Vice Detectives met with Eric Johnson the owner of Legends Sports Bar, and discussed the proposed entertainment permit conditions. Eric explained the establishment will provide live entertainment ranging from mostly a disc jockey. The Police Department is recommending entertainment activities shall be restricted to no later than 12:00 AM (Midnight) Thursday through Saturday and 10:00 PM Sunday through Wednesday. Entertainment can begin at 7:00 PM on Monday through Friday and 1:00 PM on Saturday and Sunday.

Detectives also went to this location in an undercover capacity on two separate occasions.

On Wednesday, February 5, 2020, at approximately 2000 hours, detectives went to the location. There were approximately 20 to 30 patrons inside the business drinking alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, and listening to light music with several televisions on in the background. The music was playing through the speakers inside the business, the music was low enough to enjoy a conversation. No violations were observed.

On Thursday, February 6, 2020, at approximately 1900 hours, detectives went to the location. There were approximately 30-35 patrons inside the business drinking alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. The music was playing through the speakers inside the business, the music was low enough to enjoy a conversation. No violations were observed.

#### **Recommendation**

Based upon the Vice Section's investigation, East Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, and the crime analysis, the Long Beach Police Department has determined the public's peace, safety, and welfare would not be adversely impacted by the issuance of this permit, provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant. The Police Department recommends approval of an Entertainment without Dancing Permit.
