## SECOND AMENDMENT TO REVOCABLE USE PERMIT NO. 34938 34938

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO REVOCABLE USE PERMIT NO. 34938 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of April 12, 2022, for reference purposes only, pursuant to authorization by the PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION of the City of Long Beach ("Commission") at its meeting on November 20, 2014, by and between the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City") and EL DORADO ARCHERS, INC., a California nonprofit corporation ("Permittee"), whose address is 12631 Imperial Highway, Suite E-129, Sana Fe Springs, California 90670.

WHEREAS, the City granted Permittee the non-exclusive use of the eastern portion of the Olympic Range and the Indoor/Flint Range at the El Dorado Archery Range; and

WHEREAS, Permittee may use the Permit Area for the conduct of instruction, safety classes, and member practice in archery; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a First Amendment to the Revocable Use Permit to extend the term of Permit No. 34938 and update the Use to include a three (3) foot safety perimeter around the Storage Room electrical panel;

WHEREAS, the parties again desire to extend the term of the Revocable Use Permit No. 34938 to September 30, 2023 and update Use to include additional terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in Permit No. 34938, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3.A of Permit No. 34938 is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - "A. The term of this Permit shall commence at midnight on October 1, 2014, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on September 30, 2023, unless sooner terminated as provided in this Permit.
    - 2. Section 1.F is hereby added to Permit No. 34938 to read as follows:

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"F. Permittee shall submit a proposed schedule of programming
for the proceeding six (6) months within sixty (60) days of execution of this
amendment and on October 1, and April 1 in every proceeding Permit year
thereafter. The schedule of programming shall include, dates of availability,
hours of availability, maximum class occupancy, and proposed subject
matter. The proposed schedule shall be provided at the discretion of the
tenant, and subject to the mutual approval by the Permittee and the Director
or designee, prior to provision of programming on the Premises."
3. Section 1.G is hereby added to Permit No. 34938 to read as follows:
"G. Except as set forth in Section 5, Permittee shall not make any
ts to the Permit Area without prior written approval of the Director or

- improvemen designee."
- 4. Except as expressly stated herein, all of the terms, covenants, and conditions of Permit No. 34938 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

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
