SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve expenditure not to exceed \$5,200 for materials and labor for replacing the flag pole in the median at the intersection of Glendora Avenue and 2nd Street in Belmont Shore.

DISCUSSION

Earlier in 2015 the flag pole located in the median near the intersection of Glendora Avenue and 2nd Street in Belmont Shore was severely compromised and was therefore removed. The company AAA Flag & Banner has provided the City of Long Beach with its products and services for many years, and that, among other reasons, uniquely qualifies them for this project.

At the August 20, 2015 Belmont Shore Parking and Business Improvement Area Advisory Commission meeting the commissioners approved an estimated expenditure of a not-to-exceed amount of \$3,600 for a site survey and purchase and installation of a new flag pole. As a result of the site survey, the actual cost of materials and labor necessitated an increase to \$5,041.03. The site survey fee of \$150 has already been invoiced. The remaining cost breakdown is as follows:

- \$1,872.50 – purchase of 30' pole with 8" base
- \$1,750.00 – installation of footing with footing sleeve (Day 1, 8 hours)
- \$1,250.00 – installation of flag pole (Day 2, 5 hours)
- \$168.53 – Tax
