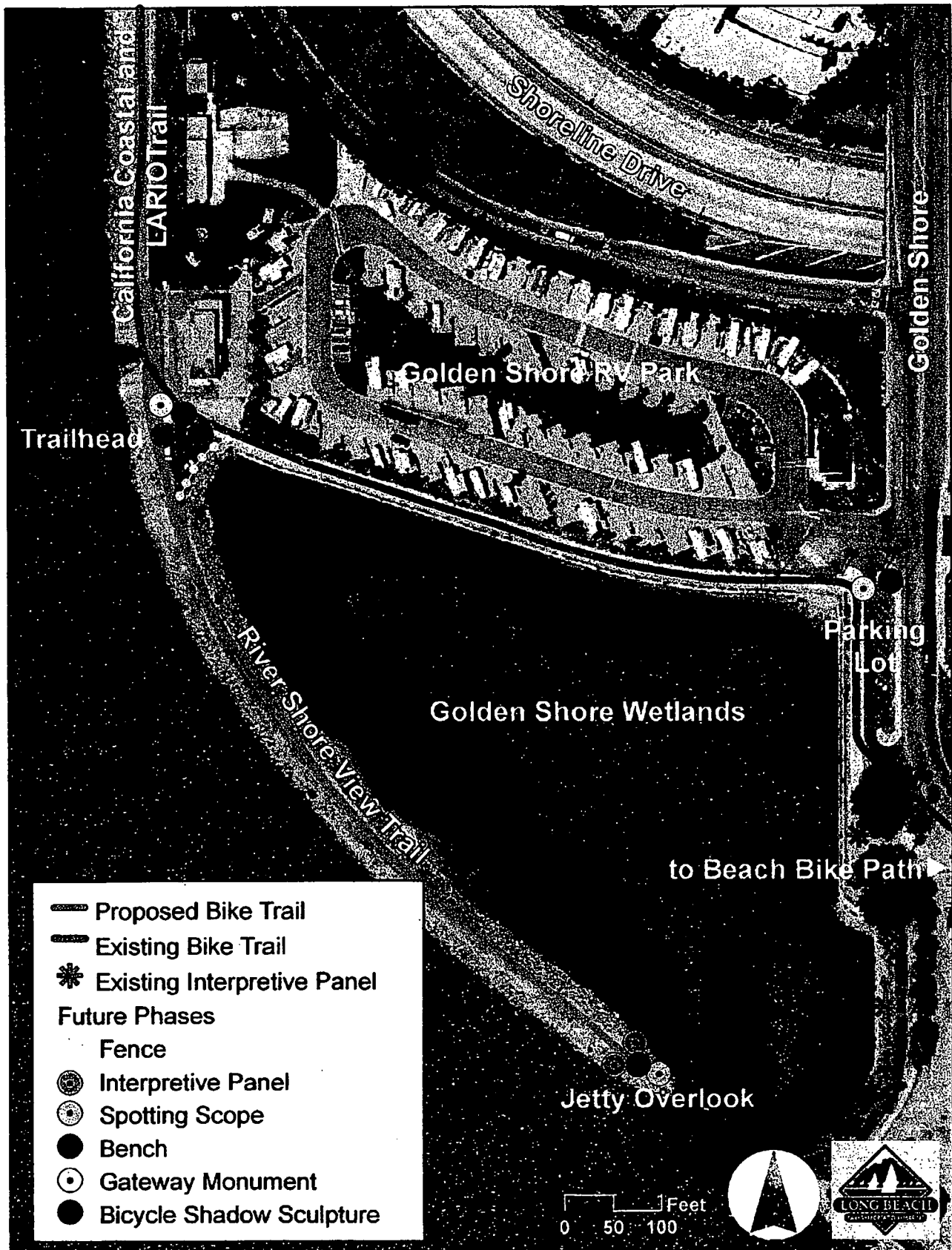

RESOLUTION NO. RES-06-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR AND EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT-IN-AID PROGRAM FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE RIVER SHORE VIEW TRAIL

WHEREAS, the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant-In-Aid program provides funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for acquiring lands and developing facilities for public outdoor recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Parks and Recreation is responsible for administration of the program in the State; and

WHEREAS, it has adopted procedures that require the City to certify by resolution the approval of City's application and the availability of eligible matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the proposed River Shore View Trail Project ("Project") is consistent with the Statewide Comprehensive Recreation Resources Plan *California Outdoor Recreation Plan - 2002*; and

WHEREAS, the Project must be compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to submit an application for funding under the Land and Water Conservation

1 Grand-In-Aid Program ("Program") for the development of the River Shore View Trail
2 ("Project").

3 Sec. 2. The City Manager is further authorized to conduct all negotiations
4 and execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications,
5 agreements, amendments, payments requests, and other documents which may be
6 necessary to complete the Project with funding through the Program.

7 Sec. 3. The City of Long Beach certifies that it has or will have available,
8 prior to commencement of any work on the Project, the funds to pay the entire cost of
9 the Project, 50% of which will be reimbursed by Program grant funds.

10 Sec. 4. The City of Long Beach certifies that the Project is compatible
11 with the land use plans of jurisdiction immediately surrounding the Project.

12 Sec. 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by
13 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this Resolution.
