RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant a One-Year Short-Term Permit with conditions on the application of S.C. Fish Grille Ltd., DBA Khoury's Restaurant, 110 N Marina Drive, for Entertainment with Dancing by Patrons. (District 3)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the permit application is complete and truthful; the applicant and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and that public peace, welfare and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved, a short-term entertainment permit shall be approved, or the application shall be denied.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) grant a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit, with or without conditions; or, 3) deny the Permit on the application.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached for your review are the departmental investigative reports, the business ownership and permit history, and the entertainment permit application.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to conditions.
- The Fire Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that approved plans be provided reflecting the new occupant load with dance areas.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that a tenant improvement permit is obtained for the dance floor.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved as a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions are in conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a restaurant with alcohol since March 1997.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy Burton on January 17, 2011.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of February 8, 2011, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$20 and Zoning Review \$15 (Development Services), Police Investigation \$1,183 (Police Department), and Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$320.70 and Regulatory \$977 (Financial Management Department).

Recommended Conditions of Operation

S.C. Fish Grille Ltd., DBA Khoury's Restaurant 110 N. Marina Drive

Application for Entertainment with Dancing

In regards to the above named permit application for Entertainment with Dancing, the Department of Financial Management recommends approval subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #1}
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #2}
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than **12:00 a.m.** Sunday through Thursday nights, and **1:00 a.m.** on Friday and Saturday nights. *{Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #3}*
- 4) Entertainment is permitted until 1:00 a.m. on holidays that fall on a Sunday through Thursday. *{New}*
- Patrons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be permitted to enter nor to remain on the premises after the restaurant (food services) portion of the establishment has closed, or **10 p.m.**, whichever comes first. Private functions not open to the public are exempt from this condition. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #4}
- 6) An identification card scanner shall be used for all patrons entering the establishment after 10:00 PM for the sole purposes of verifying patron age and/or authenticity of a patron's driver's license or identification card. {New}
- 7) This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. The authorization to provide entertainment on-site is subject to the use remaining as a restaurant, meaning a bona fide eating place serving actual and substantial meals.

"Meals" means the usual assortment of foods commonly ordered at various hours of the day; the service of such food only as sandwiches or salads shall not be deemed compliant with this requirement. Meals must consist of food prepared on the premises. Hours of sales of alcohol shall be limited to the hours when meals are available.

The premises must be equipped and maintained in good faith. The premises must possess working refrigeration, cooking equipment, utensils, menus, and enough food to make substantial meals.

In the event the primary business ceases operations, fails to operate as a bona fide eating place, fails to serve actual and substantial meals or otherwise fails to comply with this condition, the Entertainment Permit becomes null and void. {New}

- Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences on the other side of the San Gabriel River, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction. Outdoor amplified entertainment is prohibited. {New}
- 9) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM. {New}
- The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 8 a.m. *{New}*
- The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) licensed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #7}

12) In addition to the above security requirements, the permittee shall staff one (1) "Security guard" on the boat dock anytime the banquet hall is used for entertainment purposes. Security guards assigned to the dock shall ensure that patrons do not loiter near the docks or the immediate area, and ensure that NO

- ALCOHOL is permitted on the boat dock. Security guards must be identifiable as "Khoury's employees." The Chief of Police may increase or relax this condition, based upon calls for service related to problems on the boat dock. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #9}
- Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #11}
- The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors." {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #10}
- At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area. {New}
- The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-ways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras. {New}
- The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #12}
- All promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License <u>prior</u> <u>to</u> conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #14}
- The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and dancers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #15}

- 20) Khoury's, its promoters, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection at anytime. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #13}
- 21) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied. {New}
- 22) The permittee must submit an application for the renewal of the entertainment with dancing permit not later than October 2011 or four (4) months prior to the One-Year Short-Term permit expiration date. *{New}*
- The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section. {New}
- The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply. {Issued per previous permit dated 1/5/10; see condition #16}







In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment with Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval**, subject to the following nineteen (19) conditions:

Khoury's Restaurant is located at 110 Marina Drive at the south end of the Alamitos Bay Marina and serves a seafood cuisine for lunch and dinner. The business is a for-profit corporation, S.C. Fish Grill, LTD, dba Khoury's Restaurant. The corporation is owned by James Kim and currently holds a Type 47 (On-Sale General Eating Place) Alcoholic Beverage Control license. Khoury's has been operating on one-year short-term entertainment permits for the last three years because of previous compliance issues and increased calls-for-service. Based on the Police Department's investigation, the Marine Department's observations, and the East Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, the Long Beach Police Department does not believe the issuance of an Entertainment Permit with Dancing will have an adverse impact on Patrol resources.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 21.15.110 LBMC, shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to, between the hours of 10:00 AM and 1:30 AM each day of the week.
- 4) Patrons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be permitted to enter, nor to remain on the premises, after the restaurant (food services) portion of the establishment has closed, or 10 p.m., whichever comes first. Private functions not open to the public are exempt from this condition.

ENTERTAINMENT WITH DANCING AT KHOURY'S RESTURANT 110 MARINA DRIVE Page 2

This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. The premises must possess working refrigeration, cooking equipment, utensils, menus, and enough food to make substantial meals. You must offer substantial sales of meals, during the normal meal hours that you are open. Fast food, snacks, and hors d'oeuvres, shall not constitute a substantial meal. Normal meal hours are: Breakfast 6:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m., Lunch 11:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m., and Dinner 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

If you do not open by 6:00 p.m., you shall offer complete and substantial meals the entire time you are open for business, or for a minimum of three hours. In the event the primary business ceases operations or you fail to comply with this condition, your entertainment permit becomes null and void.

- Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences on the other side of the San Gabriel River, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency, and to permit deliveries. Door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- 7) The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) licensed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty people. For crowds over fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

8) In addition to the above security requirements, the permittee shall staff one (1) "security guard" on the boat dock anytime the banquet hall is used for entertainment purposes. Security guards assigned to the dock shall ensure that patrons do not loiter near the docks or the immediate area, and ensure that NO ALCOHOL is permited on the boat dock. Security guards must be identifiable as "Khoury's employees." The Chief of Police may increase or relax this condition, based upon calls for service related to problems on the boat dock.

- 9) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 10) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request.
- 11) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- 12) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- The permittee shall be responsible for installing and maintaining a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business, with full view of the public right-of-ways, and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. These cameras shall record video for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the Internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.
- 14) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of, or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- All promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License **prior to** conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters.
- 16) The permittee must provide all promoters hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.

- 17) Khoury's, its promoters, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed, or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection at anytime.
- The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 19) The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.
