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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR,
5 AND RECEIPT OF, SB 2 PLANNING GRANTS PROGRAM
6 FUNDS
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8 WHEREAS, the State of California, Department of Housing and Community
9 Development (Department) has issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) dated
10 March 29, 2019, for its Planning Grants Program (PGP); and

11 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to submit a project application for the
12 PGP program to accelerate the production of housing and will submit a 2019 PGP grant
13 application as described in the Planning Grants Program NOFA and SB 2 Planning
14 Grants Program Guidelines released by the Department for the PGP Program; and

15 WHEREAS, the Department is authorized to provide up to \$1.2 million
16 under the SB 2 Planning Grants Program from the Building Homes and Jobs Trust Fund
17 for assistance to counties and cities (as described in Health and Safety Code section
18 50470 et seq. (Chapter 364, Statutes of 2017 (SB 2)) related to the PGP Program.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
20 follows:

21 Section 1. The City Council is hereby authorized and directed to apply for
22 and submit to the Department the 2019 Planning Grants Program application released
23 March 29, 2019 in the amount of \$625,000.

24 Section 2. In connection with the PGP grant, if the application is approved
25 by the Department, the City Council is authorized to enter into, execute, and deliver a
26 State of California Standard Agreement (Standard Agreement) for the amount of
27 \$625,000, and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate
28 to evidence and secure the PGP grant, the City's obligations related thereto, and all

1 amendments thereto (collective, the "PGP Grant Documents").

2 Section 3. The City shall be subject to the terms and conditions as
3 specified in the Standard Agreement, the SB 2 Planning Grants Program Guidelines, and
4 any applicable PGP guidelines published by the Department. Funds are to be used for
5 allowable expenditures as specifically identified in the Standard Agreement. The
6 application in full is incorporated as part of the Standard Agreement. Any and all
7 activities funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the application will
8 be enforceable through the executed Standard Agreement. The City Council hereby
9 agrees to use the funds for eligible uses in the manner presented in the application as
10 approved by the Department and in accordance with the Planning Grants NOFA, the
11 Planning Grants Program Guidelines, and 2019 Planning Grants Program Application.

12 Section 4. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or
13 designee, to execute the City of Long Beach Planning Grants Program application, the
14 PGP Grant Documents, and any amendments thereto, on behalf of the City of Long
15 Beach as required by the Department for receipt of the PGP Grant.

16 Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by
17 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
