Section 1. Resolution No. C-23315, adopted March 2, 1982, is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. <u>Commission Created</u>. Pursuant to Section 15.74.465 of the Municipal Code of the City of Long Beach, there is hereby created a Cable Communications

Advisory Commission. Members of the Commission shall serve without financial remuneration.

- Sec. 2. Composition and Appointment. The Commission shall be comprised of eleven members, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council as provided in Section 509 of the City Charter, as follows:
- (a) One member shall represent community educational interests or uses of the system;
- (b) One member shall represent local institutional interests or system uses other than those related to education;
- (c) One member shall represent locally oriented news interests or uses of the system;
- (d) One member shall represent community service groups;
- (e) One member shall represent ethnic local neighborhood or community associations or organizations?
- (f) The remaining six members shall represent the community at large.
- All members shall be residents of the City of Long Beach.
- Sec. 3. Terms. The term of members of the Cable Communications Advisory Commission shall be two years.
 - Sec. 4. Responsibilities of the Commission.
- A. Except as provided in the following Subsection B, the sole responsibilities of the Cable Communications Advisory Commission shall consist of:
- (1) Advising the City Manager and the City Council on the development and use of the cable

system as a community communications system within the City of Long Beach;

- (2) Promoting and developing optimal utilization of the public access channel and setting guidelines for access channel usage; and
- (3) Annually recommending to the City Council a plan for the distribution of Communishare Funds made available by any cable franchisee under the terms of its franchise.
- B. In addition to the responsibilities set forth in Subsection A of this Section 4, the Cable Communications Advisory Commission:
- (1) May, from time to time, receive and hear concerns, comments and complaints relating to the utilization of the public access channel provided under any and all cable franchises awarded pursuant to Chapter 15.74 of the Long Beach Municipal Code and report its findings to the City Manager in order to assist him in exercising his responsibilities and authority under Subsections J and K of Section 15.74.510 of the Long Beach Municipal Code; and
- (2) Shall file with the City Manager, on or before June the thirtieth of each year during which one or more cable franchises are in effect in the City of Long Beach, a written report setting forth any findings or recommendations relating to its responsibilities relating to utilization of the public access channel as set forth in Subsection 4.A (2) of this
