## RESOLUTION NO. H. A. 1-76

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE BY-LAWS AS ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION NO. H. A. 1-69 AND AMENDED BY RESOLUTION NOS. H. A. 1-70, H. A. 7-70 AND H. A. 2-73 TO PROVIDE FOR TWO ADDITIONAL COMMISSION MEMBERS OF THE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach, California, at its regular meeting of December 10, 1968, adopted Resolution No. C-20355 declaring itself to be the Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Long Beach; and

WHEREAS, said City Council at its regular meeting of
May 11, 1976, adopted Resolution No. C-22077 amending said
Resolution No. C-20355 whereby it was provided that in addition
to the City Council members being Commissioners, two Housing
Authority tenants shall also be named as Commissioners having
the same rights, powers, duties, privileges and immunities of
any other Commissioners;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Housing Authority of the City of Long Beach, California, does hereby resolve, determine and order as follows:

A. Section 14 of Article II of the Housing Authority's By-Laws set forth in Resolution No. H. A. 1-69 is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following new Section 14 is substituted

"Section 14. COMMISSIONERS - TERM OF OFFICE. The Commissioners of the Authority are the members of the City Council of the City of Long Beach and, in addition, two tenants of the Housing Authority, one of whom is over 62 years of age. The Councilmember Commissioners shall be and act as Commissioners so long as they are members of the City Council. The tenant Commissioners shall be and act as Commissioners for a period of two years from their appointment and for only so long as they are tenants of the Authority. Their successors shall also be tenants of the Authority and shall be appointed for a period of two years. All vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term. All other officers shall act for the Authority only so long as they are employees of the City."

B. Section 5 of Article III of the Housing Authority's By-Laws set forth in Resolution No. H.A. 1-69 is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following new Section 5 is substituted in lieu thereof:

"Section 5. QUORUM. The powers of the Authority shall be vested in the Commissioners thereof in office from time to time. Six (6) Commissioners shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting its business and exercising its powers and for all other

purposes, but a smaller number may adjourn from time to time until a quorum is obtained. When a quorum is in attendance, action may be taken by the Authority upon a vote of a majority of the Commissioners present."

C. The Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Resolution by the Housing Authority of the City of Long Beach, California, and cause the same to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in said City of Long Beach, and it shall thereupon take effect.
