This Amendment is entered into by and between Infor Public Sector, Inc. ("Infor") and City of Long Beach ("Licensee") as of the last date of signature below (the "Effective Date") and amends the Order Form between the parties dated January 25, 2019 (the "Order Form"). Capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms in the Order Form.

WHEREAS Licensee licensed and received access rights to various Infor software and related professional services for the software described as "Infor Rhythm for Civics – SaaS" in the Order Form (collectively the "Rhythm for Civics Software and Services"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Infor and Licensee hereby agree as follows:

1. The Annual Subscription Fee for each of the first two Renewal Terms after the Initial Subscription Term is \$0, and for the third Renewal Term (January 25, 2024 through January 24, 2025) is \$30,000, which will be invoiced and payable according to the terms in the Order Form. For each of the first two Renewal Terms after January 24, 2025, the Annual Subscription Fee shall increase 6% or the then-current year-over-year increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U), whichever is greater (for clarity, either Infor or Licensee may choose not to enter into a Renewal Term).

2. This Amendment fully resolves all claims Licensee may have through the Effective Date, known or unknown, related to the Rhythm for Civics Software and Services.

3. All other terms and conditions of the Order Form not expressly amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.
