## RESOLUTION NO. RES-22-0097

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH SOUTHERN COMPUTER WAREHOUSE, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, PARTS AND RELATED PRODUCTS, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE **INTERLOCAL** PURCHASING SYSTEM (TIPS), IN AN ANNUAL AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000, UNTIL THE TIPS CONTRACT EXPIRES ON MAY 31, 2023, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS THE TIPS CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the 17 18 City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without 19 advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with other 20 government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

21 WHEREAS, the City requires computer equipment, parts and related 22 products; and

23 WHEREAS, the Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS), has a contract with 24 Southern Computer Warehouse, Inc. for technology solutions, products, and services, 25 Contract No. 200105 ("TIPS Contract"); and

26 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the TIPS Contract will facilitate timely 27 acquisition of the computer equipment, parts and related products as well as provide 28 considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the 1 2 TIPS Contract considerably more funds would be required; 3 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as 4 follows: 5 Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter an 6 agreement with Southern Computer Warehouse, Inc. for computer equipment, parts and 7 related products, of the same kind identified in the TIPS Contract in an annual aggregate amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000), until TIPS Contract No. 8 200105 expires on May 31, 2023, with the option to renew for as long as TIPS Contract 9 No. 200105 is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager. 10 11 Section 2.
