This noise nuisance has propagated to fireworks, vehicles with louder than allowed exhaust, vehicles going in circles at intersections with skidding tires, motorcycles on the bicycle beach path, speeding, and other, twenty-four hours a day. Also, the lack of enforcement produces a loss of revenue to which the Police Department could use for technology, hiring or resources.
