Subject: Fund Transfer Request to Support the Camerata Singers at Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Park

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Increase appropriations in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department by \$250, offset by the Sixth Council District One-Time District Priority Funds transferred from the Citywide Activities Department to provide a donation to the Long Beach Camerata Singers to support the Front Porch Concert at Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Park; and,

Decrease appropriations of the Sixth Council District One-time District Priority Funds in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department by \$250 to offset a transfer to the City Manager Department.

## **Discussion**

The Long Beach Camerata Singers is hosting a free concert in Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Park on Saturday, July 30<sup>th</sup>. The Long Beach Camerata Singers is dedicated to excellence in choral music and enriching the lives of communities and performers through a broad spectrum of repertoire, innovative programming, and arts education. In response to the pandemic, the Camerata Singers started a "Front Porch Concert" series to provide free outdoor concerts across all districts in Long Beach to keep artists employed and to keep music in our communities. The Front Porch Concert continued in Summer 2021 and is continuing this summer as well.
