lution and approved the City's Climate Action and Adaptation Plan (2205-02) (CAAP); and likewise, approved and certified a Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (EIR-03-21) to the General Plan Land Use Element and Urban Design Element Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR-SCH#2015051054) in accordance with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15164 of the CEQA Guidelines, and made certain CEQA Findings and Determinations relative thereto, including a finding that the General Plan Land Use Element Program Environmental Impact Report Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program shall apply to the approval of applicable Projects pursuant to the CAAP; and that no new or different mitigation measures are required;; WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to submit amendments to the City's Local Coastal Program, as necessary, to the California Coastal Commission for its

review and certification in accordance with Public Resources Code Section 30514 to
 ensure consistency with the City's certified Local Coastal Program and to further ensure
 that any adopted amendments will be carried out in a manner fully consistent with the
 provisions of the California Coastal Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

7 Section 1. The Director of Development Services of the City of Long 8 Beach is hereby authorized to, and shall submit, to the California Coastal Commission a 9 certified copy of any City Council adopted policy or amendments, together with all 10 appropriate supporting materials, necessary to ensure consistency between the City's 11 adopted General Plan and the Local Coastal Program that directly affect land use matters 12 in the California Coastal Zone, with a request for the Coastal Commission's earliest 13 review and action to obtain a finding of conformance with the City's certified Local 14 Coastal Program and the Coastal Commission's approval and certification as an 15 amendment(s) to the City's Local Coastal Program that will take effect automatically upon 16 Coastal Commission approval pursuant to the Public Resources Code.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
