## RESOLUTION NO. RES-10-0151

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE CELLULAR TELEPHONE AND BLACKBERRY SERVICES THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN SPRINT NEXTEL AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to participate in joint cooperative purchasing of services, supplies, materials, equipment, and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase cellular telephone and Blackberry services from Sprint Nextel; and

WHEREAS, the State of California ("State") has a contract for the purchase of Sprint Nextel services known as Price Agreement No. 7-10-70-15 ("Price Contract"); and

WHEREAS, City's participation in the Price Contract will facilitate acquisition of cellular telephone and Blackberry services as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the Price Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Sprint Nextel for the purchase of cellular
