Grant RFA Overview

Homeless Coordinating and Financing Council (HCFC)

- Mission
 - Implementation of Housing First Policies, guidelines, and regulations
 - Develop policies, identify resources, benefits and services
 - Coordinate funding and systems integration at the state and local level
 - ERF will support projects that address the immediate crisis of experiencing unsheltered homelessness in encampments
 - Develop effective, scalable, and replicable strategies

- Develop a project that is responsive to the needs of encampment residents
- Support new or enhanced cross-systems collaboration
- Restore encampments sites to original state or intended purpose
- Direct Services and Housing Options
- Capacity Building

Core Service Delivery and Provision of Housing Options

- Immediate access to NCS
- Case management services
- Resource connection
- Physical and Mental health connection
- Goal of Permanent housing

Proposed Budget and Fiscal Planning

- 1.3m for 2 years
- HSB budget allocation for ERF: \$883,000
- LBPD-QoL Budget allocation for ERF: \$81,000
- Public Works-Clean Team allocation for ERF: \$183,000
- Parks, Recreation and Marine allocation for ERF: 112,478

Progress

- 35 Individuals participating in program to date
- Case Manager is working on housing goals
- QoL support 2-3 times a week
- PRM will be conducting coordinated debris removal
- Public Works will begin work on Anaheim Corridor in the next week
