THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 35805

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 35805 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of October 27, 2022 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on May 21, 2019, by and between GOODWILL, SERVING THE PEOPLE OF SOUTHERN LOS ANGELES COUNTY, a California corporation ("Consultant"), with a place of business at 800 W. Pacific Coast Highway, Long Beach, California 90806, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City requires specialized services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with working with low-income fathers of color (and father figures) over the age of 18 that have children 24 years of age and under to strengthen family protective factors and transform the role of men as providers, friends and partners by building the social, emotional and financial capabilities of fathers ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant (the "Parties") entered into Agreement No. 35805 (the "Agreement") whereby Consultant agreed to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to update the scope of work and increase the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Second Amendment to extend the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Parties currently desire to increase the contract amount and extend the term of the contract for an additional one-year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

Section 1.A. of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows.

"Contractor shall furnish specialized services more particularly described in Exhibit "A-1", attached to this Agreement and incorporated by this reference, in accordance with the standards of the profession, and City shall pay for these services in the manner

described below, not to exceed One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000) annually, at the rates or charges shown in Exhibit "B-2"."

- 2. Exhibit "B-1" to the First Amendment to Agreement 35805 is hereby amended and replaced with Exhibit "B-2", attached hereto and incorporated herein.
 - 3. Section 2. of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows.
- "2. <u>TERM.</u> The term of this Agreement shall commence at midnight on September 30, 2020, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on September 29, 2023, unless sooner terminated as provided in this Agreement, or unless the services or the Project is completed sooner. The City shall have the option to extend the term for one (1) additional one-year period, at the discretion of the City Manager. This Agreement shall not be extended past May 21, 2024 without authorization of the City Council."
- 4. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Agreement No. 35805 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
