

RESOLUTION NO. RES-22-0204

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN MASTER SERVICE AND LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH CYPHERWORX, INC., TO PROVIDE CUSTOMIZED LEARNING CONTENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AT FACILITIES FOR PARK, RECREATION AND MARINE DEPARTMENTS, FOR A TOTAL ANNUAL CONTRACT NOT TO EXCEED \$13,407, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide online training courses to staff for Park, Recreation and Marine Department ("PRM"); and

WHEREAS, Cypherworx, Inc., of New York is a leading organization that provides training, leadership development and other resources to agencies and professionals in the out-of-school time field; and

WHEREAS, Cypherworx, Inc., has expertise in the development, manufacture and distribution of computer software and related products and services and will provide hosting and customer service which would provide PRM staff with unlimited access to California School-Age Consortium ("CalSAC") catalog of online training courses and access to reporting, course assignments, learning paths, assessments and surveys; and

WHEREAS, Cypherworx, Inc. is the only vendor that can connect PRM to the Long Beach Unified School District's training modules; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process, considerably more funds would be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter a contract with Cypherworx, Inc. to provide a customized learning content management system for the PRM department in an amount not to exceed Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred and Seven Dollars (\$13,407) for a one-year period.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
