Adopt Specifications WD-23-046 and authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with Univar Solutions USA Inc., to furnish and deliver Liquid Caustic Soda (50% solution) in an amount not to exceed \$216,000 for a period of six months.

Executive Summary

Bids for Specification WD-23-046 to furnish and deliver Liquid Caustic Soda, a water treatment chemical used at Long Beach Ground Water Treatment Plant, were opened on January 6, 2023. It was determined that the bid submitted by Univar Solutions USA Inc, conforms to all bid document requirements and is the lowest responsive bidder. Univar Solutions USA Inc. is the current Liquid Caustic Soda supplier to LBWD and is meeting performance specifications.

Recommendation

Adopt Specifications WD-23-046 and authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with Univar Solutions USA Inc., to furnish and deliver Liquid Caustic Soda (50% solution) in an amount not to exceed \$216,000 for a period of six months.

Fiscal Impact: The cost to the Water Fund will be incurred in FY 23, with the actual amounts unknown at this time but the total amount will not exceed the contract total of \$216,000 for the contract term. These costs are included in the Water Fund FY 23 Budget and financial projections.
