## RESOLUTION NO. RES-11-0033

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT ΑN APPLICATION TO CALRECYCLE (FORMERLY, "THE **CALIFORNIA** INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD") FOR A WASTE TIRE CLEANUP AND AMNESTY EVENT GRANT AND TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT FUNDS AND IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, CalRecycle is authorized by the State of California to award grants under its five-year plan for its waste tire program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to participate in the waste tire program by applying for any waste tire grant for which it is eligible, to supplement its existing waste tire cleanup efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach intends to apply any grant awarded it under the waste-tire program to conduct waste tire cleanup and waste tire amnesty events in the City; and

WHEREAS, such grants do not require matching funds or in-kind contributions; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle requires each jurisdiction applying for grants under the waste tire program to adopt a resolution authorizing such application; and

WHEREAS, if successful in its application, the City of Long Beach will enter into an agreement with CalRecycle for implementation of the projects; and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement may be extended or renewed over a fiveyear period;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

Section 1. That the City Manager of the City of Long Beach or his designee is hereby authorized to submit an application to CalRecycle for all available grants and subsequent extensions or renewals of such grants under its five-year waste tire program.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is further authorized to conduct all negotiations and execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and other documents which may be necessary to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this Resolution.
