### **Staffing Updates**

- Angela Diaz, Community Program Specialist (HMIS Sup.) started 4/10/23
- Lucy Dale, Public Health Nurse started 5/1/23
- Christine Botello, Counselor II starts 5/8/23
- Salvador De La Pena, Public Health Nurse starts 5/15/23
- HSB has 5 positions that are currently in the background process waiting for clearance for start dates.
- Positions that are in recruitment/interview phase: Health Educator II, Counselor II, Public Health Profession (REACH Mental Health Clinician)
- Recruitments that will begin in the near future: Outreach Coordinator, Assistant MSC Coordinator, CalAIM Coordinator Positions, Hilton Grant Mental Health Clinician and Substance Use Counselor



#### **Operations Update**

- The Long Beach Continuum of Care was awarded \$5.2 million through the Department of Housing and Urban Developments (HUD) Special Unsheltered Notice of Funding Opportunity. This funding will be utilized over a 3-year period to expand outreach, access, rapid rehousing and permanent supportive housing. Services to roll out in late summer
  - Mental Health America of Los Angeles: Outreach and Housing Location
  - Illumination Foundation: Rapid Rehousing for 15 families per year
  - Long Beach DHHS-HSB: Access Center and PSH for 140 households
  - Additional funding to support HMIS and Planning



#### **Operations Update Cont.**

- Winter shelter moved from Community Hospital to 702 W. Anaheim to continue as emergency shelter. The City has a 3-month lease for the building and is looking at longer-term options in order to be able to continue to have an expanded capacity year round.
- The City of Long Beach submitted a letter of interest to the County of Los Angeles regarding new state funding to create a continuum of behavior health and other specialized care. The letter outlined a proposal for \$20 million over 4 years to create new recuperative care and step down beds within Long Beach.
- The City of Long Beach was alerted that our HHAP Round 4 Application has been approved and funding can now be drawn down for the HHAP Round 4 proposed programming.


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• Long Beach Housing Authority has been awarded 79 Stability Vouchers
