Dear Chair Erick Verduzco-Vega, Vice Chair Jane Templin, and Planning Commissioners Alvaro Castillo, Josh LaFarga, Mark Christoffels and Richard Lewis:

Thank you for the opportunity to address the Planning Commission regarding the beer and wine CUP at the Grand Concession Stand near Rosie's Beach. For many years, my wife and I have observed the people and community near where Concession Stand is located. We own the apartment complexes at 5251 E. Ocean Blvd. and at 21 Nieto Ave. which is very close to the proposed CUP site. Our apartments house single adults as well as families with children.

As you know, we have a serious and growing problem with the homeless near the beach, especially with homeless sleeping in vehicles overnight in the beach parking area. The area and its sanitary conditions are deteriorating.

Adding convenient access to alcohol at the beach is not likely to enhance the beach environment and the issues we are witnessing. It has all the potential for a further nuisance and should be avoided. Going to the beach should be a place where alcohol (beer and wine) should not be promoted.

Please consider denying the CUP or at minimum postponing all decisions for beer and wine at Monty's Beach until the public can further analyze the proposal.
