
LIHEAP Background

- Federally funded and administered by the State Department of Community Services and Development
- Financial assistance for low-income gas customers
- FY 22
 - 1,802 credits issued, totaling \$843,857
- As of March 30, 2023
 - 920 credits issued, totaling \$440,098

Recommendation
