	10	WHEREAS, City and Consultant (the "Parties) entered into Agreement No.
	11	33917 (the "Agreement") whereby Consultant agreed to provide as-needed architectural
	12	services in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) for a
	13	period of two (2) years with the option to extend the term for three (3) additional one-year
	14	periods; and
	15	WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to increase the
	16	Agreement authority for a total not to exceed One Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars
	17	(\$1,400,000), and extend the term to July 19, 2018; and
	18	WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Second Amendment to increase the
	19	authority amount for a total not to exceed One Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars
	20	(\$1,900,000); and
	21	WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Third Amendment to increase the
	22	authority amount for a total not to exceed Three Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
	23	(\$3,200,000), and extend the term to July 19, 2019; and
	24	WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Fourth Amendment to extend the
	25	term to July 19, 2020; and
	26	WHEREAS, on June 9, 2020, City Council approved extending the
	27	Agreement one (1) additional one-year period; and
	28	WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Fifth Amendment to extend the term
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to July 19, 2021; and 1

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2021, City Council approved extending the 2 Agreement one (1) additional one-year period; and 3

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Sixth Amendment to increase the 4 authority amount for a total not to exceed Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars 5 (\$3,500,000), and extend the term to July 19, 2022; and 6

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2022, City Council approved extending the 7 Agreement one (1) additional one-year period; and 8

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Seventh Amendment to increase the 9 authority amount for a total not to exceed Three Million Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand 10 Dollars (\$3,750,000), extend the term to July 19, 2023, update the City Representative, 11 and attach an updated rate sheet; and 12

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Eighth Amendment to increase the 13 authority amount for a total not to exceed amount of Four Million Seven Hundred Fifty 14 Thousand Dollars (\$4,750,000); and 15

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2023, City Council approved to extend the term of 16 the Agreement by one (1) additional one-year period; and 17

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the term of the Agreement using 18 the authorized one-year period; 19

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and 20 conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows: 21

Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

TERM. The term of this Agreement shall commence at midnight on "2. 23 July 20, 2015, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on July 19, 2024, unless sooner 24 terminated as provided in this Agreement, or unless the services or the Project is 25 completed sooner." 26
