#### RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution making application to and requesting the Local Agency Formation Commission of Los Angeles County to initiate annexation/detachment proceedings for certain boundary adjustments between the cities of Long Beach, Seal Beach and Los Alamitos, and Los Angeles and Orange Counties. (Districts 3 and 5)

### **DISCUSSION**

On July 6, 2010, the City Council adopted a resolution supporting boundary adjustments between the cities of Long Beach, Seal Beach and Los Alamitos, and Los Angeles and Orange Counties. The boundary adjustments would modify the areas that are located generally along the Los Coyotes flood control channel and the San Gabriel River to better align with service delivery boundaries and physical barriers. No residential neighborhoods are impacted, and the adjustment will effectively clean up the inconsistencies for the areas. In addition to adjusting the boundary between Los Angeles and Orange Counties, there are five separate areas in the proposed boundary line adjustment between Long Beach and Seal Beach, and two separate areas between Long Beach and Los Alamitos. These areas are shown in Exhibits "A" and "B" in the accompanying resolution. The total area affected by the boundary adjustment is approximately 77.81 acres, with 35.09 acres being annexed into Long Beach, and 42.72 acres being detached from Long Beach.

Filing a formal application with the Local Agency Formation Commission of Los Angeles County (LAFCO) is the next required step in the process.

This letter was reviewed by Assistant City Attorney Michael Mais and by Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on March 21, 2011.

#### TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is requested on April 5, 2011, so the annexation application can be submitted to LAFCO.

#### RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH MAKING APPLICATION TO AND REQUESTING THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY TO TAKE PROCEEDINGS PURSUANT TO THE CORTESE-KNOX-HERTZBERG LOCAL GOVERNMENT REORGANIZATION ACT OF 2000 FOR THE CITY OF LONG BEACH TO ANNEX (AND/OR DETACH) APPROXIMATELY 77.81 ACRES OF PROPERTY

WHEREAS, City of Long Beach ("City") desires to initiate proceedings pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Reorganization Act of 2000, Division 3, commencing with Section 56000 of the Government Code, for the annexation (and/or detachment) of various areas in or adjacent to the City of Long Beach; and

WHEREAS, the City will file an application with the Local Agency Formation Commission to annex/detach said areas as set forth and more particularly described in Exhibit "A" (Chart) and Exhibit "B" (Maps), attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the proposal includes changes to the boundary line between the County of Los Angeles and the County of Orange. This proposal is processed pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 2, Division 1 of Title 3 of the Government Code (Section 23200 et seq). The proposal also includes a detachment from the City of Seal Beach, detachments from the City of Long Beach, annexations to the City of Long Beach, annexations to the City of Los Alamitos. These proposals are processed pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 (Government Code Section 56000 et seq). All proposals are

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linked and no proposal shall be effective until all proposals are effective. The two county ordinances shall state that they shall not become effective until every city change of organization is effective. Each city change of organization shall not become effective until all city changes of organization are recorded and the two county ordinances are effective; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County and Orange County Boards of Supervisors are proposing to make changes to seven (7) uninhabited areas in the boundary line between the County of Orange and the County of Los Angeles so as to cause the transfer of land as depicted in Exhibit B from Los Angeles County to Orange County and from Orange County to Los Angeles County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed annexation or reorganization shall be subject to the following terms and conditions: the annexation shall be consistent with Government Code Section 56375.3(a) and other applicable laws existing as of the date of the filing of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the reason for the proposal is to provide boundary adjustments of uninhabited areas so that the border between Los Angeles County and Orange County is more closely aligned with the Coyote Creek Flood Channel and will allow for better service delivery and improved public safety; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing will be held by the Planning Commission to prezone those land areas to be annexed to the City that require a current zoning designation;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

The City Council of the City of Long Beach, California, does Section 1. hereby approve the Resolution of Application for Annexation/Detachment, and requests that the Local Agency Formation Commission of Los Angeles County take proceedings for the annexation of territories to the City, as shown in Exhibits "A" and "B", attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, according to the terms and conditions


## County Boundary Adjustment - Area 1

Legend **Exisiting Boundary Proposed Boundary** Area 1 Parcels















