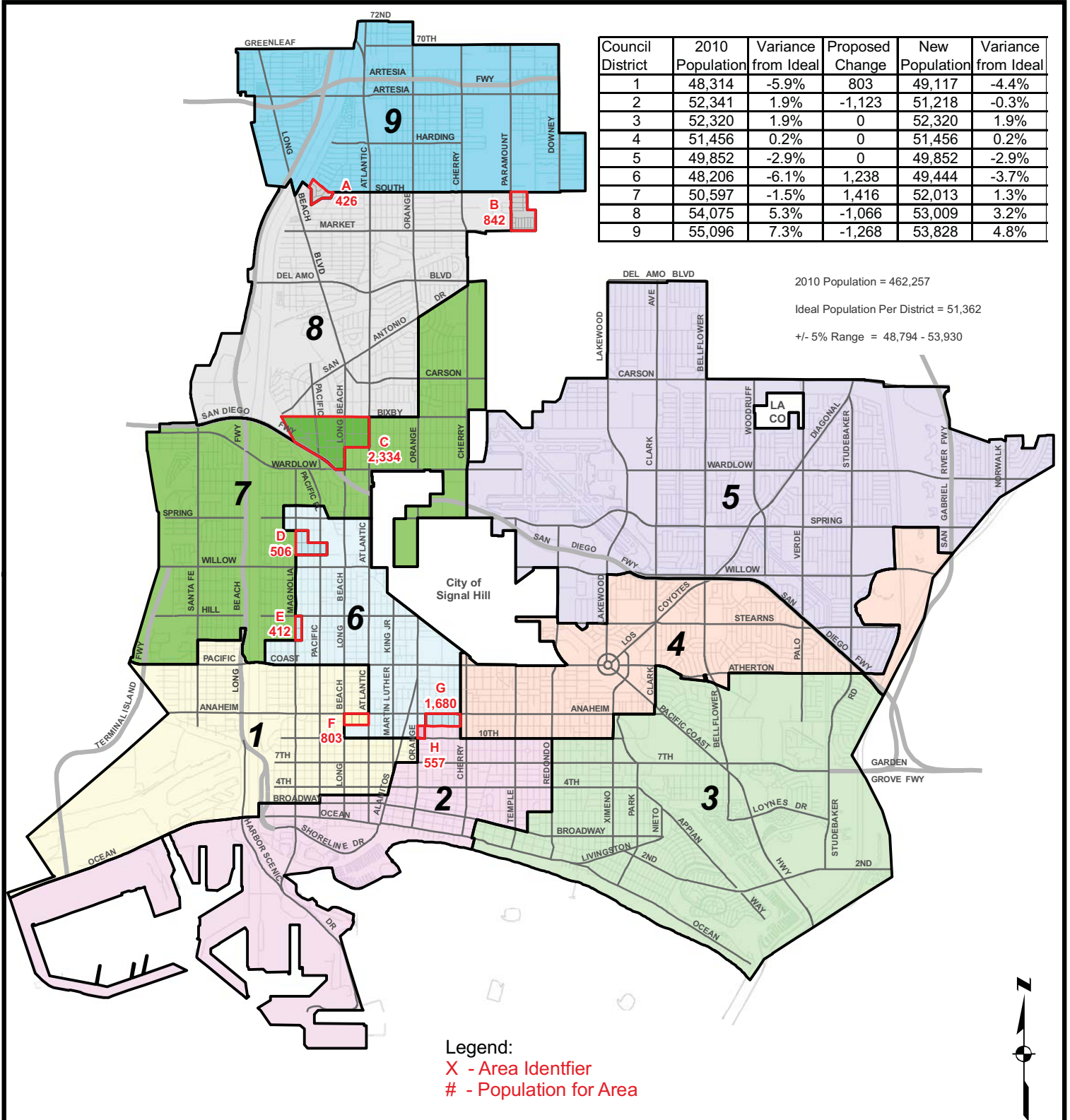

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 1.20.010
ESTABLISHING AND DESIGNATING THE POLITICAL
SUBDIVISIONS OR DISTRICTS OF THE CITY OF LONG
BEACH

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as
follows:

Section 1. Section 1.20.010 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is hereby
amended to read as follows:

1.20.010 Districts established.

The nine (9) political subdivisions or districts of the City are
respectively designated and established as follows:

Unless otherwise noted, described lines are to the centerline of
referenced streets.

A. District no. 1. That portion of the City which is now, or
hereafter shall be, within the following described boundary:

Beginning at the point of intersection of Pacific Coast Highway with
the western City boundary line, thence southeast along western City
boundary line to Anaheim Street, thence generally south and west along
the western City boundary line to the intersection with the centerline of
Ocean Boulevard; thence northeast and east along the centerline of
Ocean Boulevard to the intersection with the east line of the Los Angeles
River; thence north along the east line of the Los Angeles River to the
intersection with the westerly prolongation of Broadway; thence east along

1 said prolongation and along Broadway to Pacific Avenue; thence north
2 along Pacific Avenue to Third Street; thence east along Third Street to
3 Alamitos Avenue; thence northeast along Alamitos Avenue to Seventh
4 Street; thence east along Seventh Street to Orange Avenue; thence north
5 along Orange Avenue to Tenth Street; thence west along Tenth Street to
6 Long Beach Boulevard; thence north along Long Beach Boulevard to
7 Eleventh Street ; thence east along Eleventh Street to Atlantic Avenue;
8 thence north along Atlantic Avenue to Pacific Coast Highway; thence west
9 along Pacific Coast Highway to the northbound access road of the 710
10 Freeway; thence north along said access road and the 710 Freeway to
11 Twenty-first Street; thence west along Twenty-first Street to Gale Avenue;
12 thence south along Gale Avenue to Twentieth Street; thence west along
13 Twentieth Street to Santa Fe Avenue; thence south along Santa Fe
14 Avenue to Pacific Coast Highway; thence west along Pacific Coast
15 Highway to the western City boundary line (point of beginning).

16 B. District no. 2. That portion of the City which is now, or
17 hereafter shall be, within the following described boundary:

18 Beginning at the point of the centerline intersection of Ocean
19 Boulevard with the western Long Beach City boundary line; thence
20 northeast and east along the centerline of Ocean Boulevard to the
21 intersection with the east line of the Los Angeles River; thence north along
22 the east line of the Los Angeles River to the intersection with the westerly
23 prolongation of Broadway; thence east along said prolongation and along
24 Broadway to Pacific Avenue; thence north along Pacific Avenue to Third
25 Street; thence east along Third Street to Alamitos Avenue; thence
26 northeast along Alamitos Avenue to Seventh Street; thence east along
27 Seventh Street to Orange Avenue; thence north along Orange Avenue to
28 Eleventh Street; thence east along Eleventh Street to Gardenia Avenue;

1 thence south along Gardenia Avenue to Tenth Street; thence east along
2 Tenth Street to Redondo Avenue; thence south along Redondo Avenue to
3 Third Street; thence west along Third Street to Orizaba Avenue; thence
4 south along Orizaba Avenue to Broadway; thence west along Broadway to
5 Junipero Avenue; thence south along Junipero Avenue to Ocean
6 Boulevard; thence east along Ocean Boulevard to Eighteenth Place;
7 thence south along Eighteenth Place and the prolongation of Eighteenth
8 Place to the southern Long Beach City boundary line; thence west along
9 said southern Long Beach City boundary line to its intersection with the
10 western Long Beach City boundary line; thence northwest along said
11 western Long Beach City boundary line to its intersection with the
12 centerline of Ocean Boulevard (point of beginning).

13 C. District no. 3. That portion of the City which is now, or
14 hereafter shall be, within the following described boundary:

15 Beginning at the point of intersection of the southwest line of the
16 405 Freeway and the City of Long Beach eastern boundary line with
17 Orange County; thence proceeding south along said eastern Long Beach
18 City boundary line to the southern boundary line of the City of Long
19 Beach; thence west along said southern City boundary line to its
20 intersection with the prolongation of Eighteenth Place; thence north along
21 said prolongation of Eighteenth Place and along Eighteenth Place to
22 Ocean Boulevard; thence west along Ocean Boulevard to Junipero
23 Avenue; thence north along Junipero Avenue to Broadway; thence east
24 along Broadway to Orizaba Avenue; thence north along Orizaba Avenue
25 to Third Street; thence east along Third Street to Redondo Avenue; thence
26 north along Redondo Avenue to Tenth Street; thence east along Tenth
27 Street to Ximeno Avenue; thence north along Ximeno Avenue to Anaheim
28 Street; thence east along Anaheim Street to Clark Avenue; thence north

1 along Clark Avenue to the centerline of Atherton Street; thence east along
2 the centerline of Atherton Street to its intersection with the northerly
3 prolongation of the westerly line of Atherton Street Park; thence south
4 along said prolongation and the westerly line of Atherton Street Park to its
5 intersection with the centerline of the Los Cerritos Drain, (Bouton Creek);
6 thence southeasterly along the centerline of the Los Cerritos Drain to its
7 intersection with the southerly prolongation of the westerly line of Lot 1 of
8 Tract No. 11152, as per map recorded in Book 602, Page 81 of Maps, in
9 the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County; thence north
10 along said prolongation and the westerly line of said Lot 1 to its
11 intersection with the centerline of Atherton Street; thence east along the
12 centerline of Atherton Street to its intersection with the northerly
13 prolongation of the easterly line of said Lot 1 of Tract No. 11152; thence
14 south along said prolongation and the easterly line of said Lot 1 to its
15 intersection with the centerline of the Los Cerritos Drain; thence
16 southeasterly along the centerline of the Los Cerritos Drain to its
17 intersection with the southerly prolongation of the centerline of San
18 Anseline Avenue; thence north along said prolongation of the centerline of
19 San Anseline Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Atherton
20 Street; thence east along the centerline of Atherton Street to the
21 southwest line of the 405 Freeway; thence southeast along the southwest
22 line of the 405 Freeway to the City of Long Beach/Orange County
23 boundary line (point of beginning).

24 D. District no. 4. That portion of the City which is now, or
25 hereafter shall be, within the following described boundary:

26 Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Atherton Street
27 with the centerline of the Los Cerritos Drainage Channel; thence west
28 along the centerline of Atherton Street to its intersection with the centerline

1 of San Anseline Avenue; thence south along the southerly prolongation of
2 the centerline of San Anseline Avenue to its intersection with the
3 centerline of the Los Cerritos Drain, (Bouton Creek); thence northwesterly
4 along the centerline of the Los Cerritos Drain to its intersection with the
5 southerly prolongation of the easterly line of Lot 1 of Tract No. 11152, as
6 per map recorded in Book 602, Page 81 of Maps, in the office of the
7 County Recorder of Los Angeles County; thence north along said
8 prolongation and the easterly line of said Lot 1 to its intersection with the
9 centerline of Atherton Street; thence west along the centerline of Atherton
10 Street to its intersection with the northerly prolongation of the westerly line
11 of said Lot 1 of Tract 11152; thence south along said prolongation and the
12 westerly line of said Lot 1 to its intersection with the centerline of the Los
13 Cerritos Drain; thence northwesterly along the centerline of the Los
14 Cerritos Drain to its intersection with the southerly prolongation of the
15 westerly line of Atherton Street Park; thence north along said prolongation
16 and the westerly line of Atherton Street Park to its intersection with the
17 centerline of Atherton Street; thence west along the centerline of Atherton
18 Street to Clark Avenue; thence south along Clark Avenue to Anaheim
19 Street; thence west along Anaheim Street to Ximeno Avenue; thence
20 south along Ximeno Avenue to Tenth Street; thence west along Tenth
21 Street to Gardenia Avenue; thence north along Gardenia Avenue to
22 Anaheim Street; thence north along the prolongation of Gardenia Avenue
23 to Fourteenth Street; thence north along Gardenia Avenue to Nineteenth
24 Street; thence east along Nineteenth Street and along the prolongation of
25 Nineteenth Street to the City of Long Beach/City of Signal Hill boundary
26 line; thence southeast along said Long Beach/Signal Hill boundary line to
27 Pacific Coast Highway; thence east along the Long Beach/Signal Hill City
28 boundary line (coterminous with Pacific Coast Highway) to Reservoir Drive

1 West; thence northwest, west and east along the City of Long Beach/City
2 of Signal Hill boundary line to Redondo Avenue; thence south along
3 Redondo Avenue to Stearns Street; thence east along Stearns Street to
4 Euclid Avenue; thence southeast along Euclid Avenue to Mira Mar
5 Avenue; thence northeast and north along Mira Mar Avenue to Stearns
6 Street; thence east along Stearns Street to Lakewood Boulevard; thence
7 north along Lakewood Boulevard to Willow Street; thence east along
8 Willow Street to the centerline of the 405 Freeway; thence east and
9 southeast along the centerline of the 405 Freeway to its intersection with
10 the centerline of Atherton Street; thence east along the centerline of
11 Atherton Street and the east prolongation of the centerline of Atherton
12 Street to the west line of the San Gabriel River; thence northeast and
13 north along the west line of the San Gabriel River to a point on the east
14 prolongation of the south line of El Dorado Park Golf Course boundary as
15 described in the lease agreement for Contract No. 17448 between the City
16 of Long Beach and American Golf Corporation and being on file in the
17 office of the City Clerk; thence west along said prolongation to the
18 southeast corner of said El Dorado Park Golf Course boundary; thence
19 west and generally northerly along said golf course boundary as described
20 in said contract to an angle point at the south line of Willow Street; thence
21 north to the centerline of Willow Street; thence east along the centerline of
22 Willow Street to the west line of the City of Los Angeles, Department of
23 Water and Power Easement; thence north along said west line of
24 easement to the centerline of Spring Street; thence east along the
25 centerline of Spring Street to a point on the north prolongation of the west
26 line of El Dorado Park Area 1 Community Gardens boundary as described
27 in the lease agreement for Contract No. 25527 between the City of Long
28 Beach and Long Beach Community Garden Association, Inc. and being on

1 file in the office of the City Clerk; thence south along said prolongation and
2 said west line to the southwest corner of the property described in said
3 contract; thence east along the south boundary of said property and the
4 east prolongation of the south boundary to a point on the City of Long
5 Beach/Orange County boundary line; thence southwesterly along said
6 Long Beach/Orange County boundary line to the intersection with the
7 southwest line of the 405 Freeway; thence northwest along the southwest
8 line of the 405 Freeway to the centerline of Atherton Street; thence west
9 along the centerline of Atherton Street to the centerline of the Los Cerritos
10 Drainage Channel (point of beginning).

11 E. District no. 5. That portion of the City which is now, or
12 hereafter shall be, within the following described boundary:

13 Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Atherton Street
14 with the centerline of the 405 Freeway; thence northwest along the
15 centerline of the 405 Freeway to Willow Street; thence west along Willow
16 Street to Lakewood Boulevard; thence south along Lakewood Boulevard
17 to Stearns Street; thence west along Stearns Street to Mira Mar Avenue;
18 thence south and southwest along Mira Mar Avenue to Euclid Avenue;
19 thence northwest along Euclid Avenue to Stearns Street; thence west
20 along Stearns Street to Redondo Avenue; thence north along Redondo
21 Avenue to the City of Long Beach/City of Signal Hill boundary line; thence
22 northerly, westerly, southwesterly, northerly, westerly, northerly and
23 westerly along said Long Beach/Signal Hill boundary line to Cherry
24 Avenue; thence north along Cherry Avenue to the City of Long Beach/City
25 of Lakewood boundary; thence following said Long Beach/Lakewood
26 boundary line easterly, northerly and southerly to the City of Long
27 Beach/Orange County boundary line; thence southwesterly along said
28 Long Beach/Orange County boundary line to a point on the east

1 prolongation of the south line of the El Dorado Park Area 1 Community
2 Gardens as described in the lease agreement for Contract No. 25527
3 between the City of Long Beach and the Long Beach Community Garden
4 Association, Inc., and being on file in the office of the City Clerk; thence
5 west along said prolongation and said south line to the southwest corner
6 of the property described in said contract; thence north along the west
7 boundary of said property and the north prolongation of the west boundary
8 to a point on the centerline of Spring Street; thence west along the
9 centerline of Spring Street to the west line of the City of Los Angeles,
10 Department of Water and Power Easement; thence south along said west
11 line to the centerline of Willow Street; thence west along the centerline of
12 Willow Street to a point north of an angle point in the El Dorado Park Golf
13 Course boundary as described in the lease agreement for Contract No.
14 17448 between the City of Long Beach and American Golf Corporation
15 and being on file in the office of the City Clerk; thence south to the angle
16 point in said boundary, being also on the south line of Willow Street;
17 thence generally southerly and easterly along said golf course boundary
18 and the easterly prolongation of said boundary to a point on the west line
19 of the San Gabriel River; thence south and southwest along the west line
20 of the San Gabriel River to a point on the east prolongation of the
21 centerline of Atherton Street; thence west along said east prolongation
22 and the centerline of Atherton Street to the centerline of the 405 Freeway
23 (point of beginning).

24 F. District no. 6. That portion of the City which is now, or
25 hereafter shall be, within the following described boundary:

26 Beginning at the point of intersection of Pacific Coast Highway and
27 the southerly prolongation of San Francisco Avenue; thence north along
28 said prolongation and San Francisco Avenue to Twentieth Street; thence

1 east along Twentieth Street to Magnolia Avenue; thence north along
2 Magnolia Avenue to Twenty Ninth Street; thence west along Twenty Ninth
3 Street to Maine Avenue; thence north along Maine Avenue to Thirty First
4 Street; thence east along Thirty First Street to the west line of the Pacific
5 Electric Railroad Right of Way; thence southeast along the west line of the
6 Pacific Electric Railroad Right-of-Way to Spring Street; thence east along
7 Spring Street to the City of Long Beach/City of Signal Hill boundary line;
8 thence south and southeast along the City of Long Beach/City of Signal
9 Hill boundary line to its intersection with the prolongation of Nineteenth
10 Street; thence west along said prolongation of Nineteenth Street and
11 along Nineteenth Street to Gardenia Avenue; thence south along
12 Gardenia Avenue to Fourteenth Street; thence south along the
13 prolongation of Gardenia Avenue to Eleventh Street; thence west along
14 Eleventh Street to Orange Avenue; thence south along Orange Avenue to
15 Tenth Street; thence west along Tenth Street to Long Beach Boulevard;
16 thence north along Long Beach Boulevard to Eleventh Street; thence east
17 along Eleventh Street to Atlantic Avenue; thence north along Atlantic
18 Avenue to Pacific Coast Highway; thence west along Pacific Coast
19 Highway to Daisy Avenue East (point of beginning).

20 G. District no. 7. That portion of the City which is now, or
21 hereafter shall be, within the following described boundary:

22 Beginning at the point of intersection of the western Long Beach
23 City boundary and the 405 Freeway; thence north and east along the
24 western Long Beach City boundary line to Santa Fe Avenue; thence south
25 along Santa Fe Avenue to the 405 Freeway; thence east and southeast
26 along the 405 Freeway to the Metro Blue Line Right of Way; thence
27 northwest along the Metro Blue Line Right of Way to the intersection of the
28 westerly prolongation of Bixby Road; thence east along Bixby Road to

1 Orange Avenue: thence north along Orange Avenue to San Antonio Drive;
2 thence northeast along San Antonio Drive to Cherry Avenue; thence north
3 along Cherry Avenue to the City of Long Beach/City of Lakewood
4 boundary line; thence east, south and west along said City boundary line
5 to Cherry Avenue; thence south along Cherry Avenue to Spring Street;
6 thence west along Spring Street to Orange Avenue; thence south along
7 Orange Avenue to Willow Street; thence west along Willow Street to
8 California Avenue; thence north along California Avenue to Spring Street;
9 thence east along Spring Street to the City of Long Beach/City of Signal
10 Hill boundary line; thence following said Signal Hill boundary line north,
11 east, west and south around the northern part of Signal Hill to Spring
12 Street; thence west along Spring Street to the west line of the Pacific
13 Electric Railroad Right of Way; thence northwest along the west line of the
14 Pacific Electric Right of Way to Thirty First Street; thence west along Thirty
15 First Street to Maine Avenue; thence south along Maine Avenue to Twenty
16 Ninth Street; thence east along Twenty Ninth Street to Magnolia Avenue;
17 thence south along Magnolia Avenue to Twentieth Street; thence west
18 along Twentieth Street to San Francisco Avenue; thence south along San
19 Francisco Avenue and the southerly prolongation of San Francisco
20 Avenue to Pacific Coast Highway; thence west along Pacific Coast
21 Highway to its intersection with the northbound access road of the 710
22 freeway; thence north along the northbound access road and the 710
23 Freeway to Twenty First Street; thence west along Twenty First Street to
24 Gale Avenue; thence south along Gale Avenue to Twentieth Street;
25 thence west along Twentieth Street to Santa Fe Avenue; thence south
26 along Santa Fe Avenue to Pacific Coast Highway; thence west along
27 Pacific Coast Highway to the western Long Beach City boundary line;
28 thence north and east along said western City boundary line to its

1 intersection with the 405 Freeway (point of beginning).

2 H. District no. 8. That portion of the City which is now, or
3 hereafter shall be, within the following described boundary:

4 Beginning at the point of the intersection of the northbound exit
5 ramp of the 710 Freeway with Long Beach Boulevard; thence south along
6 Long Beach Boulevard to a point on the centerline of the Los Angeles
7 River; thence northeast along the centerline of the Los Angeles River to a
8 point on the northwest prolongation of Chestnut Avenue; thence
9 southeasterly along said northwest prolongation to De Forest Avenue;
10 thence northeast along De Forest Avenue to South Street; thence
11 southeast and east along South Street to the easterly Long Beach City
12 Boundary line that is located within the alley east of Orizaba Avenue;
13 thence south, east, south and west along said boundary line to Cherry
14 Avenue; thence south along Cherry Avenue to San Antonio Drive; thence
15 southwest along San Antonio Drive to Orange Avenue; thence south along
16 Orange Avenue to Bixby Road; thence west along Bixby Road to the
17 intersection of the prolongation of Bixby Road and the Metro Blue Line
18 Right of Way; thence southeast along the Metro Blue Line Right of Way to
19 the 405 Freeway; thence northwest and west along the 405 Freeway to
20 Santa Fe Avenue; thence north along Santa Fe Avenue to its intersection
21 with the western Long Beach City boundary line; thence north along said
22 boundary line to an angle point in said boundary line opposite the
23 northbound 710 Freeway exit ramp for Long Beach Boulevard; thence
24 crossing the 710 Freeway easterly along the prolongation of the City
25 boundary from the west to the northbound exit ramp for Long Beach
26 Boulevard; thence along said exit ramp to its intersection with Long Beach
27 Boulevard (point of beginning).

28 I. District no. 9. That portion of the City which is now, or

hereafter shall be, within the following described boundary:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the northbound exit ramp of the 710 Freeway with Long Beach Boulevard, thence south along Long Beach Boulevard to a point on the centerline of the Los Angeles River; thence northeast along the centerline of the Los Angeles River to a point on the northwest prolongation Chestnut Avenue; thence southeasterly along said northwest prolongation to De Forest Avenue; thence northeast along De Forest Avenue to South Street; thence southeast and east along South Street to the easterly Long Beach City Boundary line that is located within the alley east of Orizaba Avenue; thence east along the Long Beach City Boundary line parallel to South Street to the westerly Long Beach City boundary line, thence along said boundary line north, west, south and east to the intersection of the 710 Freeway; thence crossing the 710 Freeway easterly along the prolongation of the City boundary line to the northbound exit ramp for Long Beach Boulevard; thence northeast along said northbound exit ramp to its intersection with Long Beach Boulevard (point of beginning).

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.
