



Marina History

- 3,677 slips in three marinas, built from the 1950s to the 1980s
- Adoption of Marina Strategic Plan in 1999
- Total Marina Rebuild project estimated to cost well over \$100 million











Marina Rebuild Phased Approach

- First Phase was the rebuild of the Shoreline and Rainbow Marinas
- Phase was completed in 2007
- Funding consisted of \$32 million of State loan funds and \$5 million of marina enterprise accumulated capital

- More Complex project
 - Significant Dredging
 - Seawall Repair
 - Pile Replacement
 - CEQA Process
- Regulatory Permits in Place
 - EIR Approved by Planning Commission December 2009
 - Coastal Permit Received April 2011
 - Army Corps of Engineers Permit Received April 2011





- Phase 1 to include:
 - Basin 4 Docks, Including Required Dredging
 - Basin 4 Marina Restroom
 - Basin 4 Parking Lots
 - Long Beach Yacht Club Long Dock
 - Eelgrass Mitigation Site



- Total Phase 1 Cost \$23,700,000
- Funding Sources for Phase 1-
 - 2003 State Loan \$8,250,000
 - 2011 State Loan \$9,970,000
 - Marina Enterprise Accumulated Capital \$6,200,000





August 9, 2011 actions:

- Accept Department of Boating and Waterways loan of \$9,970,000
- Increase marina slip fees to cover the debt service
- Add \$6,430,000 to the Bellingham Marine contract to complete Phase 1





• Financial Analysis by Finance Department indicates sufficient Marina Enterprise funds to fund Phase 1 debt, with the Marina Fee increases recommended for FY 12.

• City Auditor support for Phase 1.
