A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF

RESOLUTION NO. RES-12-0033

APRIL AS GENOCIDE AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, on April 24, 1915, the Armenian Massacres involved the 7 systematic killing of the Armenian population of the Ottoman Empire during and just after 8 World War I. The total number of Armenians killed is generally believed to be as many as 9 one and a half million people; and 10

WHEREAS, in April of 1933, a Nazi Germany decree was created, which 11 paved the way for the annihilation of over six million European Jews and millions of others that were deemed non-Arian such as Russians, homosexuals, and Catholics 13 during World War II; and 14

WHEREAS, on April 17, 1975, the Cambodian Communists regime or 15 Khmer Rouge started its four year reign of terror and indiscriminate executions at 16 17 numerous "Killing Fields" that resulted in the death of two million people in Cambodia; 18 and

19 WHEREAS, on April 5, 1992, the siege of Sarajevo propelled a campaign of ethnic cleansing in Bosnia. Serbia set out to "ethnically cleanse" Bosnian territory by 20 systematically removing all Bosnian Muslims. The ethnic cleansing campaign killed more 21 than 8,000 Bosnian Muslims as well as the mass expulsion of another 25,000 - 30,000 22 23 Bosnians: and

24 WHEREAS, in April of 1994, the Rwandan Genocide began which claimed the lives of more than 800,000 people. Over the course of 100 days, approximately 25 26 500,000 people were killed; and

27 WHEREAS, in April of 2003, civilians in Sudan's Darfur region were attacked, thus starting a killing spree of over 400,000 people. Two and a half million 28

people have been displaced in a genocide that continues today; and

WHEREAS, we, the people of Long Beach, pay tribute and honor in the name of humanity to those who suffered unimaginable tragedy, as well as to remind ourselves that future atrocities can be prevented through awareness and action;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Foster, Mayor of Long Beach, and the Long Beach City Council, do hereby proclaim the Month of April as the Official Genocide Awareness Month for the City of Long Beach:

Sec. 1. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
