Roswitha Winnen-Walker has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of her employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on September 3, 2013, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Roswitha Winnen-Walker, based upon a 96 percent disability rating, with future provision for a life pension at the rate of \$139.15 per week after the permanent disability has been paid, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
