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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH RETRACTING IMPLEMENTATION
5 OF GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 20636(c)(4)
6 PURSUANT TO SECTION 20691 AS TO PAYING AND
7 REPORTING THE VALUE OF EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER
8 CONTRIBUTIONS FOR EMPLOYEES REPRESENTED BY
9 THE LONG BEACH ASSOCIATION OF ENGINEERING
10 EMPLOYEES, LONG BEACH MANAGEMENT
11 ASSOCIATION, LONG BEACH ASSOCIATION OF
12 CONFIDENTIAL EMPLOYEES, AND UNREPRESENTED
13 MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES TO THE CALIFORNIA
14 PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM (CalPERS)
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16 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement
17 Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

18 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or agreement
19 which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the
20 employer, and reported as special compensation; and

21 WHEREAS, the City has engaged in negotiations with the Long Beach
22 Association of Engineering Employees, Long Beach Management Association, and Long
23 Beach Association of Confidential Employees and the parties have agreed to amend the
24 Memorandum of Understanding with respect to payment and reporting of the value of
25 employer paid member contributions (EPMC); and

26 WHEREAS, members of the Long Beach Association of Engineering
27 Employees, Long Beach Management Association, and Long Beach Association of
28 Confidential Employees have agreed to pay the full member contribution; and

1 WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this change is
2 the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of a resolution giving notice
3 of its intention to cease paying and reporting the value of employer paid member
4 contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the group or class as identified
5 herein.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
7 follows:

8 Section 1. Effective as of November 16, 2013, the governing body of the
9 City of Long Beach shall retract its previous implementation of Government Code Section
10 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691 as to paying and reporting the value of Employer
11 Paid Member Contributions (EPMC) for all employees represented by Long Beach
12 Association of Engineering Employees, Long Beach Management Association, Long
13 Beach Association of Confidential Employees, and unrepresented management
14 employees. In so doing, the City will pay zero percent (0%) and report the same percent
15 (0%) and the member will pay one hundred percent (100%) of the normal member
16 contribution which is currently eight percent (8%) of the member's compensation.

17 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
18 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

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
