RESOLUTION NO. RES-13-0117

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE URBAN GREENING GRANT PROGRAM UNDER THE SAFE DRINKING WATER, WATER QUALITY AND SUPPLY, FLOOD CONTROL, RIVER AND COASTAL PROTECTION BOND ACT OF 2006 (PROPOSITION 84)

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for the program shown above; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Growth council has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the grant program, establishing necessary procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the Strategic Growth council require a resolution certifying the approval of application(s) by the City Council of the City of Long Beach before submission of said application(s) to the State; and

WHEREAS, the City, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of California to carry out the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the filing of an application for landscaping improvements on the street median adjacent to Pacific Coast Highway and east of the Terminal Island Freeway (the "Project").

Section 2. The City Council hereby certifies that the City understands the assurances and certifications in the application, will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the Project consistent with the land tenure requirements; or will secure the

1 resources to do so, and certifies that it will comply with the provisions of Section 1771.8  
2 of the State Labor Code regarding payment of prevailing wages on Projects awarded  
3 Proposition 84 Funds.

4           Section 3.    The City Council certifies that the Project will comply with any  
5 laws and regulations including, but not limited to, legal requirements for building codes,  
6 health and safety codes, disabled access laws, environmental laws and, that prior to  
7 commencement of construction, all applicable permits will have been obtained, and  
8 certifies that the City will work towards the Governor's State Planning Priorities intended  
9 to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the environment, and promote public  
10 health and safety as included in Government Code Section 65041.1.

11           Section 4.    The City Council appoints the City Manager, or designee, as  
12 agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not  
13 limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be  
14 necessary for the completion of aforementioned Project.

15           Section 5.    This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
16 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

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
