Save Long Beach Aquatics History – Pool Tile Re-purpose Project

Preserve pool tiles and aspects of the existing Belmont Pool and facilities during demolition. Include pictures on the walls to be repurposed and incorporated into the new facilities. These could be part of the new entry; a fountain and/or mural.



Rationale:

- At Ohio State pieces of the pool were auctioned off. Bricks and tiles were cut into small pieces, with felt put on the bottom and made into paperweights or plaques. It was a huge success.
- Belmont tiles could be auctioned or sold, then signed by anyone who swam competed or trained at Belmont between 1968-2013.
- Combining contacts in swimming, diving and water polo we could get the support and help from former Olympians.

Community Involvement

- Incorporate local youth by utilizing David Russell with the Mobile Mural Lab.
- Work with schools to help children feel vested in the new pool and the community.
- Mobile Mural Lab offers education programs by developing K-12 educational standards into a processed based learning exchange through mural painting and its historical/social significance.
- Project can take pieces of the demolished building and create artwork and incorporate these tiles or pieces into a mural of a collage of great events at Belmont.
- A collage of great athletes at Belmont; timeline era and /or a fountain could be one of those projects.



- There should be a gift/aquatics shop within the site.
- This is the ideal spot to showcase the Aquatic Hall of Fame.

- Could have fundraising nights in which Long Beach athletic teams sell dinners and serve them. A percentage would go to each team.
- Starla to design the menus to make them unique and fun!
