## REQUESTED ACTION:

Respectfully request a brief presentation from Food Finders about their campaign to collect new pajamas, slippers, books and robes for children aged infant to 18 years old by way of residential donations at drop off locations of participating businesses.

## DISCUSSION:

For those working 9 to 5, *Casual Friday* has revolutionized the office as employees go from buttoned-up to buttoned down on the last day of the work week.
