If the Planning Commission and the City Council wish to adopt a new ordinance in Title 21 of the Long Beach Municipal Code regulating the operation of medical marijuana dispensaries in the City of Long Beach, the Office of the City Attorney recommends that the ordinance address the following issues:

- Conditional Use Permits;
- Cultivation;
- Security measures;
- Video surveillance;
- Site size restrictions not to exceed 2,500 square feet;
- Accounting and financial reporting requirements;
- Fire and burglar alarm systems;
- Sound absorption;
- Odor absorption ventilation and exhaust systems;
- Edible products;
- Lighting requirements;
- Signage requirements for exterior signage and signs visible from the exterior;
- Lab testing requirements;
- Pesticide and chemical free cultivation;
- City inspection authority;
- Per sale quantity restrictions;
- Hours of operation;
- Age requirements for employees;
- Marijuana storage;
- Dispensary membership restrictions;
- Background check requirements for participants; and
- Revocation and suspension of permits.
