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FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 33132

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 33132 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of December 5, 2013 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on January 17, 2012, by and between LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, a California nonprofit corporation, with offices located at Nutrition Services Branch, 3333 Airport Way, Long Beach, California 90806 (hereafter "Subcontractor"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a California municipal corporation (hereafter "Contractor" or "City").

WHEREAS, Contractor has entered into a Letter of Agreement for the HEAL Zone Initiative: Coalition for a Healthy North Beach (hereafter "Prime Contract") with the California Community Foundation (hereafter "Foundation") and Kaiser Foundation Hospitals (hereafter "KFH")(collectively as the "Grantor"); and

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill its obligations to Grantor under the Prime Contract, Contractor desires to engage Subcontractor to provide for community-specific strategies in an effort to create a healthy North Long Beach; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Subcontract No. 33132 whereby Subcontractor agreed to perform such work; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the contract term by an additional one-year period and increase the contract sum by \$12,000 for such extended period for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$17,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions contained in the Subcontract and this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

- Section 3 of Subcontract No. 33132 is amended to read as follows:
- "3. TERM OF SUBCONTRACT. The term of this Subcontract shall commence on October 1, 2012 and shall expire on September 30, 2014, unless terminate earlier pursuant to any of the conditions for termination in the Prime Contract."
 - 2. Section 4.1 of Subcontract No. 33132 is amended to read as follows:

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"4.1 Contractor shall compensate Subcontractor a total maximum c	ontact	
sum not to exceed Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$17,000) for the term	of this	
Subcontract to provide the services designate in Section 2.0 of this Subcontract."		

- 3. The Scope of Work in Exhibit "B" to the Agreement is hereby amended to include additional services for the extended period from October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014 as more particularly described in Exhibit "B-1", attached hereto and incorporated by this reference.
- 4. Except as expressly amended in this First Amendment, all terms and conditions in Subcontract No. 33132 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

Subcontractor Objectives:

- 1. Provide additional varieties of fresh fruits and vegetables that go beyond the current USDA requirements at HEAL Zone schools.
- 2. Train cafeteria staff from HEAL Zone Schools to better promote and market fresh fruit and vegetable offerings.
- 3. Work with Coalition for a Healthy North Long Beach partners and students at the HEAL Zone schools to identify and taste new fruit and vegetable offerings as part of the school meals program (at least one tasting at King, Grant, Hamilton, and Jordan).
- 4. Continue the removal of flavored milk and provide evaluation results of milk consumption at HEAL Zone schools.
- 5. Attend and engage in Coalition for a Healthy North Long Beach meetings and events as an active member.
- 6. Submit invoices and reports quarterly by the 10th of January, April, July and October 2014.

Budget:

LBUSD is allocated \$12,000 for this grant period. Funds will pay for NSB staff to increase the varieties of fresh fruit and vegetable menu offerings at HEAL Zone school sites and the supporting activities.
