

SIXTEENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 23214

THIS SIXTEENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 23214 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of April 11, 2006 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on April 18, 2006, by and between COMPUDYNE-PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE, INC., a Virginia corporation, formerly known as TIBURON, INC., a Virginia corporation, ("CompuDyne") and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Agreement No. 23214 whereby Tiburon agreed to provide specialized data processing services relating to computer-aided dispatching and records management systems for City's Police and Fire Departments ("Project") and to grant a license and maintenance for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement has previously been amended to extend the term and to add services; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire again to amend the Agreement to purchase an upgrade to the system;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in Agreement No. 23214 and in this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, any previous amendment, or in any attachment or exhibit to the Agreement and previous amendments, CompuDyne shall provide the upgrades and perform the services described on Attachment "A" attached to this Sixteenth Amendment and incorporated by this reference. City shall pay the fees for the upgrades and services identified on Attachment "A" in an amount not to exceed \$135,000.00.

2. The effective date of this Amendment shall be April 20, 2006, and CompuDyne's obligations to perform the upgrades and services described in this Amendment shall be completed by December 31, 2006.

3. Except as expressly amended in this Amendment, all terms and

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1 conditions in Agreement No. 23214 (as previously amended, to the extent consistent
2 with this Amendment) are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and
3 effect.

Attachment A

HUMAN RESOURCE INTERFACE

Upon authorization from the Long Beach Police Department Upgrade Manager, Compudyne will provide a scope of work for an interface between the City of Long Beach's Human Resource system and the Compudyne personnel system. The scope of work will provide functionality to automatically update the Tiburon personnel records from the City of Long Beach's Human Resource database. Data field will be identified for Compudyne prior to the request for the scope of work. Work shall not begin on this project until acceptance of the scope of work, which will be authorized by the Long Beach Police Department Upgrade Manager. The interface will not exceed \$25,000.

PROPERTY BAR CODING 7 .5

Upon authorization from the Long Beach Police Department Upgrade Manager, Compudyne will provide a scope of work for the Property bar coding 7 .5 module. This module is a baseline add on which will provide the ability for the Long Beach Police Department to control and manage all in custody property through the bar coding module. Work shall not begin on this project until acceptance of the scope of work, which will be authorized by the Long Beach Police Department Upgrade Manager. The property bar coding enhancement cost is \$53,000 plus hardware. The exact hardware is yet to be determined based on a site visit of two other agencies. The Long Beach Police Department Upgrade Manager will provide Compudyne with an exact list of hardware needs. Compudyne will provide an invoice of the cost, which will be approved by the upgrade manager prior to purchasing. Hardware costs are not to exceed \$22,000. Any unspent funds from the hardware purchase may be used for the optional CAD/RMS enhancements.

OPTIONAL ENHANCEMENTS – Will not exceed \$35,000 plus the remaining balance from the property hardware purchase.

OPTIONAL CAD ENHANCEMENTS

Upon authorization from the Long Beach Police Department Upgrade Manager, Compudyne will provide a scope of work for CAD enhancements. Work shall not begin on this project until acceptance of the scope of work, which will be authorized by the Long Beach Police Department Upgrade Manager.

OPTIONAL RMS 7.5 ENHANCEMENTS

Upon authorization from the Long Beach Police Department Upgrade Manager, Compudyne will provide a scope of work for RMS enhancements. Work shall not begin on this project until acceptance of the scope of work, which will be authorized by the Long Beach Police Department Upgrade Manager.

PROJECT CHANGE CONTROL PROCEDURES

Any changes that either party may wish to make to the statements of work above after authorization shall be reviewed by both parties to assess the cost and schedule impacts of those changes . All changes must be approved in writing on a document of their choosing executed by the respective Upgrade Managers.
