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### FOURTEENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 23214

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THIS FOURTEENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 23214 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of January 17, 2006 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on December 20, 2005, by and between COMPUDYNE-PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE, INC., a Virginia corporation, formerly known as TIBURON, INC., a Virginia corporation, ("CompuDyne") and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Agreement No. 23214 whereby Tiburon agreed to provide specialized data processing services relating to computer-aided dispatching and records management systems for City's Police and Fire Departments ("Project") and to grant a license and maintenance for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement has previously been amended to extend the term and to add services; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire again to amend the Agreement to add services relating to installation of the System at the City's Airport;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in Agreement No. 23214 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. All references in the Agreement and its amendments, attachments and exhibits to "Tiburon" shall after the execution of this Fourteenth Amendment mean and refer to "CompuDyne."
- 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, any previous amendment or in any attachment or exhibit to the Agreement and previous amendments, CompuDyne shall provide the system and services described on Exhibit "A" attached to this Fourteenth Amendment and incorporated by this reference. City shall pay the fees for the system and services identified on Exhibit "A" in an amount not to exceed \$20,678.00 which is comprised of \$18,828 for training and \$1,850 for maintenance. City shall pay fifty percent (50%) of \$18,828 on execution of this

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Fourteenth Amendment by the City and the remaining fifty percent (50%) on achievement of the completion criteria which is defined as conclusion of the 5-day on-site service.

- 2. The effective date of this Fourteenth Amendment shall be February 1, 2006.
- 3. Except as expressly amended in this Fourteenth Amendment, all terms and conditions in Agreement No. 23214 (as previously amended, to the extent consistent with this Amendment) are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

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## **EXHIBIT "A"**

### **Description of Services**

CompuDyne-Public Safety & Justice, Inc. ("Compu-Dyne") shall add the Long Beach Airport as a new DAREA in the Stratus CAD.

In addition, CompuDyne shall provide the following assistance:

- 1) Three consecutive days in Long Beach to assist the City's staff at the Long Beach Airport in the creation of the DAREA(s) and to train them for file maintenance and table maintenance.
- 2) Two consecutive days, on a separate occasion from the 3-day trip described above, to verify the work completed by the City's staff, to assess their readiness to place the DAREA(s) into production, and to assist City's staff in actually placing the DAREA(s) into production.
