FLIGHT SLOT ALLOCATIONS:

At month-end, Long Beach Airport had 41 allocated Air Carrier flight slots - JetBlue (32), US Airways (5), Delta (2), FedEx (1), UPS (1) and six allocated Commuter Carrier flight slots - Delta (3), Alaska (3).

Nineteen Commuter Carrier flight slots remain available for allocation.

## DEFINITIONS:

Total Passenger Traffic – Total number of airline passengers both enplaned (departures) and deplaned (arrivals).

Air Carrier – Scheduled passenger or cargo airline, certificated under FAR Part 121, 125 or 135, with maximum takeoff weight of 75,000 lbs or over. Commuter Carrier - Scheduled passenger or cargo airline, certificated under FAR Part 121, 125 or 135, with maximum takeoff weight under 75,000 lbs. Air Cargo – Cargo carried by aircraft, both inbound and outbound.
