RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant an Entertainment Permit with conditions on the application of Casto Corporation, Inc., DBA The Brit, 1744 East Broadway, for entertainment with dancing by patrons. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council shall approve the issuance of the entertainment permit if they find that: the issuance of the permit at the proposed location is consistent with federal, state and local laws, rules, and regulations; it will not constitute an undue burden on the neighborhood; the applicant(s) or responsible persons have not been convicted of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or felony offense within the past five years; and, neither the applicant(s) or any responsible persons have a history of committing significant violations of the City code and have not provided false or misleading information on their application.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) deny the Permit on the application. Once the Permit is granted, pursuant to LBMC 5.72.120.5, the Permit will be subject to an administrative review by the Department of Financial Management every two years. This review process will consist of a multi-department analysis to determine compliance and identify if issues exist. This provision does not affect the City's ability to modify, revoke or suspend a permit at any time.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached for your review are the departmental investigative reports, history, entertainment permit application and floor plan. To review all supportive documents, as well as the documents included in this report, you may visit www.longbeach.gov/finance/business-relations/entertainment.asp.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to the conditions.
- The Fire Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.
- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions are in conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a bar/tavern/lounge business category since November 1982.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy R. Webber on October 21, 2014.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of February 3, 2015, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$22 and Zoning Review \$16 (Development Services), Police Investigation \$1,240 (Police Department), and Mailing List \$90 (Financial Management Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$340.95 and Regulatory \$1,035 (Financial Management Department).

Recommended Conditions of Operation

Casto Corporation Inc., DBA The Brit 1744 East Broadway Application for Entertainment With Dancing

The Department of Financial Management recommends **approval** of the Permit subject to the following conditions:

I. STANDARD CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LMBC Chapter 8.80).
- 4) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction. Outdoor amplified entertainment is prohibited.
- 5) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.
- 6) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.
- 7) The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) uniformed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional uniformed security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 8) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors" or something similar.
- 9) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the front of the establishment, the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 10) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City for all costs associated with excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 11) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320).
- 12) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 13) All independent contractors and promoters must have, or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters or independent contractors.
- 14) The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and dancers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.

- 15) The business, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.
- 16) If the permittee utilizes an independent third party event promoter to provide entertainment related services resulting in any public safety call for service, the City reserves the right to remove and/or restrict the use of independent third party promoters.
- 17) The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-ways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.
- 18) The permittee shall within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.
- 19) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.

II. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) Entertainment activities indicated on page 7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to Friday and Saturday and shall end at 1:00 A.M.
- 2) Entertainment on the following holidays is permitted until 1:30 A.M.: New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, St. Patrick's Day, Cinco De Mayo, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, and Halloween.
- 3) There shall be no live entertainment or dancing on the patio at any time.

- 4) There shall be no access to the patio after 9:00 P.M. during hours of entertainment.
- 5) The permittee is required to monitor the outside patio area for any nuisance activity that could disturb the surrounding neighbors. This shall be done by utilizing security guards or employees.
- 6) There shall be no "queue" allowed after 12:00 A.M. midnight Friday and Saturday nights. Queue is defined as persons awaiting entry after the business is at capacity.
- 7) No owner, operator, or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to enter the premises, at any time.





In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment With Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval** of an Entertainment with Dancing Permit, subject to the following twenty-three (23) conditions:

The Brit is a bar located on the south side of Broadway between Gaviota Avenue and Hermosa Avenue. The business is a for-profit corporation, Castro Corporation Incorporated. The corporation has existed for over 30 years, and holds a valid Type 48 (On Sale General Public Premises) Alcoholic Beverage Control license. On June 28, 2014, The Brit applied for an Entertainment with Dancing Permit, requesting dancing by performers, recorded amplified music, and a disc jockey.

Based upon the Vice Section's investigation, the West Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, and input from neighborhood residents, the Long Beach Police Department has determined the public peace, safety, and welfare would not be adversely impacted by the issuance of this permit, provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant. The Police Department recommends approval of an Entertainment with Dancing Permit.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council shall approve the issuance of the entertainment permit if they find that: the issuance of the permit at the proposed location is consistent with federal, state and local laws, rules, and regulations; it will not constitute an undue burden on the neighborhood; the applicant(s) or responsible persons have not been convicted of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or felony offense within the past five years; and, neither the applicant(s) or any responsible persons have a history of committing significant violations of the City code and have not provided false or misleading information on their application.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) deny the Permit on the application. Once the Permit is granted, pursuant to LBMC 5.72.120.5, the Permit will be subject to an administrative review by the Department of Financial Management every two years. This review process will consist of a multi-department analysis to determine compliance and identify if issues exist. This provision does not affect the City's ability to modify, revoke or suspend a permit at any time.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached for your review are the departmental investigative reports, history, entertainment permit application and floor plan. To review all supportive documents, as well as the documents included in this report, you may visit www.longbeach.gov/finance/business relations/entertainment.asp.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to the conditions.
- The Fire Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.
- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions are in conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a bar/tavern/lounge business category since November 1982.

- 4) The permittee is required to monitor the outside patio area for any nuisance activity that could disturb the surrounding neighbors. This shall be done by utilizing security guards or employees.
- 5) There shall be no "queue" allowed after 12:00 A.M. midnight Friday and Saturday nights. Queue is defined as persons awaiting entry after the business is at capacity.
- 6) No owner, operator, or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to enter the premises, at any time.





In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment With Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval** of an Entertainment with Dancing Permit, subject to the following twenty-three (23) conditions:

The Brit is a bar located on the south side of Broadway between Gaviota Avenue and Hermosa Avenue. The business is a for-profit corporation, Castro Corporation Incorporated. The corporation has existed for over 30 years, and holds a valid Type 48 (On Sale General Public Premises) Alcoholic Beverage Control license. On June 28, 2014, The Brit applied for an Entertainment with Dancing Permit, requesting dancing by performers, recorded amplified music, and a disc jockey.

Based upon the Vice Section's investigation, the West Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, and input from neighborhood residents, the Long Beach Police Department has determined the public peace, safety, and welfare would not be adversely impacted by the issuance of this permit, provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant. The Police Department recommends approval of an Entertainment with Dancing Permit.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to Friday and Saturday and shall end at 1:00 A.M.

- 7) There shall be no "queue" allowed after 12:00 A.M. midnight Friday and Saturday nights. Queue is defined as persons awaiting entry after the business is at capacity.
- 8) No owner, operator, or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to enter the premises, at any time.
- 9) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LMBC Chapter 8.80).
- 10) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and window(s) shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency, and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) shall not consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- 11) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) uniformed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty people. For crowds over fifty people the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional uniformed security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

Security guards must be identifiable as "The Brit" employees. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for police service, the permittee may be required to increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary.

- The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by utilizing security guards and signage with verbiage such as, "Please respect our neighbors", or something similar.
- 14) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 15) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time. This information shall be provided to public safety personnel upon request.
- 16) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City of Long Beach whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of, or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 17) All independent contractors and promoters must have, or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters or independent contractors.
- 18) The permittee must provide all promoters, or independent contractors hired to conduct entertainment activities, with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.
- The Brit, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, any vehicle or in any other such place in the City of Long Beach. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.
- 20) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict between the requirements of this permit, your conditional use permit, or your Alcoholic Beverage Control license, the more stringent regulation shall apply.

- The permittee shall be responsible for installing and maintaining a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business, with full view of the public right-of-ways, and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. These cameras shall record video for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras
- Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the permittee shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 23) The permittee shall ensure that all employees attend an alcohol awareness class such as TIPS or LEAD, within the first ninety (90) days of employment. The permittee shall keep employee's proof of completion on file, and be available for inspection at any time.
